

Accessibility Information | Braybrook Community Hub Drop-In

Location:

Braybrook Community Hub,
107–139 Churchill Avenue,
Braybrook Victoria 3019.

Braybrook Community Hub is located in Braybrook, in Melbourne's west. The venue is accessible via Ballarat Road and Churchill Avenue, within a 15 to 25 minute drive from Melbourne's CBD.

Parking:

40 on-site parking spaces are available at Fraser Rise Children's and Community Centre and surrounding streets. Free on-site parking is available at Braybrook Community Hub.

Designated disability parking:

7 accessible parking spaces are available in the on-site car park. The main entrance is approximately 100 metres from the car park, via a flat, step-free pathway with a gentle slope.

Public transport:

Braybrook Community Hub is accessible via bus.

- **Bus:** Routes 408 and 410 stop at Skinner Reserve on Churchill Avenue, approximately 50m from the main entrance.

Public transport travel time from Melbourne CBD is approximately **40 minutes to 60 minutes**.

Facilities:

Accessible facilities are available onsite, throughout the venue.

- Braybrook Community Hub features step-free access throughout, accessible parking, accessible toilets, and a hearing induction loop in the Community Hall and Library Meeting Room 4.
- Accessible main entrance with two automatic sliding double doors (1220mm wide each).
- Accessible toilets on-site: one left-hand accessible, one right-hand accessible, and one right-hand accessible with shower.
- Braille signage is available on some signage outside rooms (not comprehensive throughout the venue).
- Wi-Fi available on-site.
