Gold Coast Highway traffic changes

West Burleigh Road to Tweed Street, Burleigh Heads

Work areas will be established along the Gold Coast Highway between West Burleigh Road and Tweed Street, Burleigh Heads from 27 August 2023 to early 2024.

What to expect

- Increase in construction activity including noise, vibration and vehicle movements
- The use of heavy machinery including excavation and asphaltting equipment, saw cutting and jack hammering
- The use of temporary lighting (where night works are required).

While every effort will be taken to minimise impacts, these works will be noisy and disruptive at times.

Traffic changes

A construction zone will be established in the middle of the Gold Coast Highway between West Burleigh Road and Connor Street, Burleigh Heads (see map overleaf). Changes include:

- The right turn onto Connor Street will temporarily close for the duration of works
- Changed traffic conditions around Memorial Park and Goodwin Terrace
- Tweed Street will permanently close, local access to businesses will be maintained
- Bus stop relocations and closures on the northbound and southbound carriageways.

Motorists can expect reduced speed limits, changes to traffic flow and short-term traffic disruptions.

Traffic management will assist motorists to safely navigate around the works area.

Parking changes

Night works - Centre median removal

The centre median between West Burleigh Road and Connor Street will be removed from 27 August for up to four weeks.

For the safety of motorists and our workers, this activity will be completed at night when traffic volumes are at their lowest.

Nearby residents and businesses can expect an increase in noise. Where possible louder activities will be completed by 10pm.

Timing

Day works will be carried out between 6.30am and 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday.

Night works will be carried out between 6.30pm and 6.30am, each night from Sunday night to Friday morning. Advanced notification will be provided to directly impacted stakeholders.

No works will occur on public holidays unless otherwise notified.

Wet weather or unforeseen circumstances may result in changes to the work schedule.

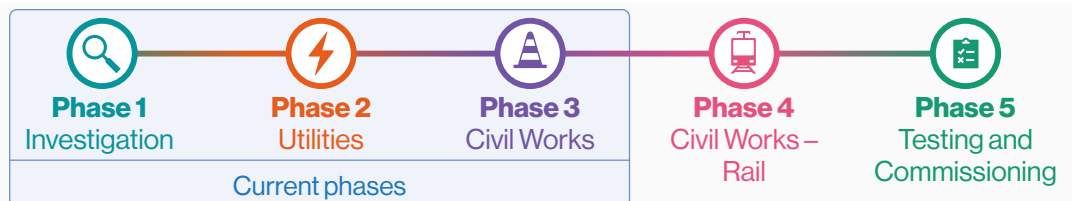

Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 3 (GCLR3) is a 6.7 kilometre extension of the light rail network from Broadbeach to Burleigh Heads and is funded by the Queensland and Australian governments in partnership with City of Gold Coast. This city-shaping project will support more than 760 jobs and cater to the Gold Coast's expected population growth in the coming decades.
