## Dear neighbour

The NSW Government is delivering a new Sydney Fish Market which will retain its authentic experience and strengthen its position as one of Australia's leading tourist destinations.

### Upcoming work - Site hoarding installation

Starting **Monday 30 August 2021**, we will be installing construction hoarding along the Glebe Foreshore Walk and replacing the current hoarding along Bridge Road.

Glebe Foreshore works will start on 30 August and be carried out between **7:00am and 5:30pm** for a period of three days.

Bridge Road works will start on Thursday 2 September and be carried out between 7:00am to 5:30pm Monday to Friday and 7:30am to 3:30pm Saturday for a period of ten days.

It is noted that these dates are subject to change pending inclement weather, and potential impacts of the NSW Government lockdown restrictions.

The necessary approvals and agreements with relevant stakeholders have been obtained to conduct these works.

# How this affects you

- Access to the Glebe Foreshore Walk will be maintained, however ushers will be in place to safely guide pedestrians along the footpath for the duration of the works.
- To install the hoarding, the walkway will be temporarily narrowed with a physical barricade to delineate the work zone (see Figure 1).




Figure 2: Pedestrian Access during works - Bridge Road

- Access to the Bridge Road footpath will be reduced but maintained for the duration of works, with traffic control and signage to safely guide pedestrians along the work zone (see Figure 2).

We understand the potential impacts this may cause to the local community.
