
Nighttime drilling and lane closures on Don Valley Parkway near Millwood Road (Leaside Bridge)

Expected duration: May 30 to September 2023

Timing: 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.



What is happening?

Metrolinx will conduct drilling on the Don Valley Parkway to study ground conditions. The information gathered will be used to help design the bridge and tunnel portal, which will make it possible for Ontario Line trains to cross the Don Valley.

What to expect

- One northbound and/or one southbound lane will be closed within the general work area.
- These temporary closures will take place at nighttime, from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- At least two lanes will remain open in each direction.
- Residents near the work area may hear noise from drilling, hydrovac trucks, and other construction equipment.
- Work may be rescheduled or postponed due to unforeseen circumstances.

About the project

- The Ontario Line will be a 15.6-kilometre subway line that will make it faster and easier to travel within Toronto and beyond.
- The line will bring 15 new stations to the city and will run from Exhibition Place, through downtown, all the way to Don Mills Road and Eglinton Avenue.
- It will accommodate nearly 400,000 daily trips and provide significant relief from crowding throughout the existing transit network thanks to connections to more than 40 other subway, GO train, LRT, streetcar, and bus routes.
