Weekend work and temporary traffic changes in April 2025 in Cammeray & Neutral Bay

Warringah Freeway Upgrade

April 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Cammeraygal people of the Eora nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

We are simplifying the Warringah Freeway, making it safer and easier to use, and more efficient and reliable for the benefit of all road users, including public transport users.

Over two weekends in April, we will be working along the freeway in Cammeray and Neutral Bay. This work includes work over the Easter long weekend when traffic volumes are lower. We work over weekends to speed up the work program and reduce our overall impact to the surrounding community.

What are we doing?

Work on the northbound and reversible lanes on the freeway between Miller Street and Falcon Street

From 10pm Friday 11 April to 6pm Sunday 13 April 2025, we will be working between Miller Street, Cammeray and Falcon Street, Neutral Bay.

We will be:

- realigning lanes
- asphalting and line marking
- installing barriers and light poles.

Northbound closures for the Falcon Street shared user bridge work

From **10pm on Friday 11 April**, the existing Falcon Street shared user bridge will be closed for approximately 14 weeks. During this closure, we will dismantle the existing bridge and work will continue to complete the new shared user bridge.

From **10pm Thursday 17 April** work will take place between Falcon Street and Ernest Street, Cammeray, to safely remove the old bridge structure.

We will be:

- setting up traffic controls and safety barriers
- setting up and dismantling cranes
- · saw cutting of the existing structure
- removing the existing shared user bridge in two crane lifts.

Work on the new Falcon Street bus ramp

From **10pm Friday 11 April to 6pm Sunday 13 April** we will be working on the new Falcon Street bus ramp.

We will be:

• installing barriers and panels on the ramp.

Over the Easter long weekend, from 10pm Thursday 17 April to 5am Monday 21 April 2025, we will be 'stitching' the Falcon Street road bridge to the new Falcon Street southbound bus on ramp. This will be done by pouring concrete along the joint between the southern side of Falcon Street road bridge and the new bus on ramp.

We will be:

- setting up traffic controls and safety barriers
- pouring concrete to connect the Falcon Street bus on ramp to the traffic lanes.

The concrete needs time to completely set before vehicles can use the lanes next to it. Extended lane closures westbound along Falcon Street must remain in place over the weekend.

Temporary Easter long weekend traffic changes

We will set up multiple temporary lane and ramp closures along the freeway and on adjacent streets during the weekend work. Please plan ahead and allow extra travel time and follow the direction of traffic control. Visit LiveTraffic.com for the latest traffic updates.

Managing our impacts

Some of the work activities will require the use of machinery that generates noise, light, and vibration. We implement extensive controls to ensure any noise impacts are mitigated as much as possible.

Some of the work activities will require the use of machinery that generates noise, light, and vibration. We implement extensive controls to ensure any noise impacts are mitigated as much as possible.

To minimise the impact of this work we will:

- turn off machinery when not in use
- use acoustic blankets to minimise noise, where practicable
- direct temporary lighting down and away from properties
- fit equipment with devices to minimise noise, particularly non-tonal reversing beepers.

To carry out work on three consecutive nights, we have temporarily altered the standard out of hours work schedule permitted under our Environmental Protection Licence (EPL). We will not exceed working 10 nights per month. The standard EPL condition permits us to work up to three nights per week and up to 10 nights per month with no more than two consecutive nights of high-noise work.
