After three years of construction, the roadworks component of the M6 Stage 1 is nearing completion. During this time, we have made significant upgrades to President Avenue. You will still notice ongoing finishing work such as footpath, kerbs and gutters, drainage and asphalt resurfacing throughout the year. We greatly appreciate the community's patience and support during this process.

During 2025, both permanent and temporary changes will be introduced to President Avenue to improve road safety and traffic flow.

What work are we doing?

Roadworks day activities

- Pavement upgrade on Civic Avenue and on President Avenue between Crawford Road and Princess Highway.
- Property adjustment activities on the northern and southern side of President Avenue. Impacted property owners will be contacted directly.

Roadworks day and night activities

- Signage and signal installation, including trenching to install conduits and piling to install equipment, signage and signals on West Botany Street between President Avenue and Bermill Street, on President Avenue between Princes Highway and West Botany Street, and between O'Neill Street and The Grand Parade.
- Stormwater drainage upgrades across President Avenue, Princes Highway and West Botany Street.

- Footpath and pavement upgrades on West Botany Street between President Avenue and Green Street, in Cross Lane and on President Avenue between Princes Highway and Crawford Road.
- Utility and stormwater drainage upgrades and pavement and pedestrian pathway construction at the C6 compound (former 7-Eleven site).
- Traffic signal adjustments at locations including Princes Highway, West Botany Street and O'Connell Street. This may include minor pedestrian adjustments at these locations.
- Street lighting and power pole replacement on President Avenue between West Botany Street and O'Neill Street.
- Collecting and relocating stockpiled material, delivering and relocating equipment and oversized plant at our compound sites in O'Neill Street, Colson Crescent, Civic Avenue, our Bicentennial Park compound and the C6 compound.
- Commencement of Moorefield Avenue intersection signalisation works.

Roadworks night activities

- Pavement and median upgrades on President Avenue, Princes Highway, West Botany Street and O'Connell Street.
- Excavating and upgrading road surfaces and repainting line markings as required along President Avenue, Princes Highway and West Botany Street.



- Continuing finishing works, including kerbs, gutters and completing the median on Princes Highway and President Avenue, between Princes Highway and Crawford Road.
- Upgrading of watermain works on Princes Highway.

Day activities at our Rockdale Bicentennial Park, MOC3 and O'Neill Street construction sites, and on West Botany Street

- Ongoing access and upgrades to utilities (sewer, gas main and electrical infrastructure) on West Botany Street, between Kings Road Footpath and French Street.
- Ongoing utility investigations and monitoring near MOC3, as well as in and around Bicentennial Park and Kirby Industrial Estate.
- Pavement upgrade within O'Neill Street construction site.
- Steel fixing, scaffolding and pavement work and pouring concrete within the tunnel portal, and at MOC3.
- Precast concrete and masonry wall installation within the tunnel portal and at MOC3.
- Internal fit-out, electrical and mechanical installation work and deliveries to MOC3 and for the shared pathway in Bicentennial Park.
- Ongoing structure and drainage upgrades, dewatering, excavation, installation of conduits and lighting poles within the tunnel portal and for the shared pathway.
- Landscaping work, earthworks (including the use of vibratory roller), vegetation and tree removal, and construction of retaining wall for the shared pathway.
- Concrete works for construction of the President Avenue and Bado Berong bridge and shared pathway.
- Welding, painting, scaffolding and installation of lighting poles, handrails, and drainage pipes for President Avenue bridge.
- Stormwater drainage upgrades within Rockdale Bicentennial Park carpark area.

Night activities at our Rockdale Bicentennial Park, MOC3 and O'Neill Street construction sites, and on West Botany Street

- Ongoing gas main relocating and installing electrical and communication conduits, pipes and pits on West Botany Street along Rockdale Bicentennial Park.
- Upgrading drainage and relocating electrical utilities at the Kirby Industrial Estate.

- Steel fixing, pouring concrete, precast panel, mechanical and electrical installations at MOC3.
- Ongoing steel fixing, dewatering, precast installation and excavating in Bicentennial Park.
- Pouring concrete in Bicentennial Park for the tunnel portal.
- Welding, painting, scaffolding and installation of lighting poles, handrails, and drainage pipes for President Avenue bridge.
- Collecting and delivery of equipment, materials, and oversized plant at MOC3 and Bicentennial Park.

When and where we'll be working

Our standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm, Saturday. We are approved to work out-of-hours from 6pm to 7am, for up to three weeknights per week, no more than two consecutive weeknights and a maximum of 10 nights per month per zone.

Planned out-of-hours work dates and zones during April

Zone A East – President Avenue, from President Avenue Bridge to O'Connell Street

• 1, 3, 8, 10, 14 and 15 April

Zone A West – President Avenue, from West Botany Street to President Avenue Bridge

• 2, 4, 9, 11, 14 and 15 April

Zone B – President Avenue, from Oakdale Avenue to Princes Highway

- 2, 4, 9, 11, 14, 15, 22, 23, 29 and 30 April
- Contingency nights: 24 and 25 April

Zone C – Princes Highway, from Green Street to South Street and Cross Lane to Princes Highway

• 2, 4, 9, 11, 14 and 15 April

West Botany Street, from the Kings Road footpath to President Avenue and Rockdale Bicentennial Park

• 2, 4, 9, 11, 14 and 15 April

East Zone - President Avenue, from The Grand Parade to Crawford Road

• 2 and 3 April

Please note, independent utility companies may undertake day or night work which may result in temporary service interruptions this month.

These outages may temporarily affect gas, water, telecommunications, and electricity of certain properties, and may extend beyond the approved work hours for the M6 Stage 1 project.

Utility providers will send out notifications to affected properties.

What will this mean for you?

Temporary local traffic changes mean that there is no right turn form the Moorefield Estate onto President Avenue until new traffic signals are installed at Moorefield Avenue later this year.

- Oakdale Avenue: left in and left out only.
- Cross Street: left in and left out only.
- Princes Highway at President Avenue (southbound) will change with the left most lane allowing a left turn onto President Avenue. A dual dedicated left turn slip lane onto President Avenue will be added.
- Temporary driveway access restrictions will be progressively implemented on the northern side of President Avenue between Cross Street and West Botany Street. Impacted residents will be contacted directly.

Managing our impacts

Properties near our work areas will experience noise and vibration, particularly during certain activities such as rock breaking, piling activities and vibratory rolling.

We regularly monitor noise, dust, and vibration near our sites and ensure appropriate mitigation measures are in place, including:

- using water dust suppression and street sweepers and carrying out air quality monitoring
- using construction methods and equipment that cause less vibration and investigate less noisy or vibratory options
- positioning plant and equipment away from properties, and from each other, while in use
- installing sound walls or temporary fencing with noise blankets using non-tonal movement alarms and noise control kits, such as exhaust mufflers
- pausing high impact noise and vibration activities every three hours to provide respite.

Our out of hours stormwater drainage and signage and signalling work on President Avenue and West Botany Street will involve trenching, hammering, rock breaking, and piling in some locations. You may notice noise and vibration during this work.

Separate notifications have been distributed via letterbox and email to impacted residents for the above works.

Boom gates, concrete barriers and stop-slow traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of workers and the community when working on or near live traffic. Temporary road closures and pedestrian diversions may be in place to facilitate works.
