



## Learning outcomes

### Hard Hat design and cut-out (primary schools)

<b>Descriptor</b>	Students will discuss the importance of wearing a Hard Hat and other PPE as they design and cut out a hard hat to wear.
<b>Age</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Grades 3 – 4</li></ul>
<b>Duration of activity</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 60 minutes</li></ul>

<b>Aims</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Promote safety awareness and emphasise how to stay safe around construction sites</li><li>• Promote awareness of the safety measures builders must follow on-site</li><li>• Foster creativity and personal expression</li></ul>
<b>Overview</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students design their own Hard Hat and colour it in</li><li>• Students cut-out and wear their Hard Hat</li><li>• Students showcase and explain their design</li></ul>
<b>Lesson Ideas</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Conducting the Hard Hat activity after watching the Safety Video allows a discussion about what the students have learned in the video about safety overall and why construction workers are wearing hard hats</li><li>• Discuss the reason behind PPE with students and how construction sites can use different coloured hard hats to signify various roles</li><li>• Wearing the Hard Hat they designed engages students in a role-play scenario.</li></ul>
