

Accessibility Information | Gisborne Community Centre Drop-In

Location:

Gisborne Community Centre,
8A Hamilton Street,
Gisborne Victoria 3437.

Gisborne Community Centre is located in the Macedon Ranges township of Gisborne and includes a hall, meeting rooms and kitchen facilities. The venue is accessible by car and local public transport, within approximately **45 to 60 minutes drive** from Melbourne's CBD.

Parking:

Public parking is available adjacent to Gisborne Community Centre.

Designated disability parking:

Four disability parking spaces are available in the public car park of Gisborne Community Centre.

Public transport:

Gisborne is serviced by local Gisborne Transit routes, including low-floor, wheelchair-accessible vehicles.

- **Train:** Bendigo V/line services stop at Gisborne Station, approximately 3.4km the venue.
- **Bus:** Gisborne Transit routes 73 and 74 operate on set routes around the Gisborne township, while route 77 operates as an on-demand book-and-ride service. Aitken St/Hamilton St, is approximately 100m from the venue via Hamilton Street Service Road.

Public transport travel time from Melbourne CBD is approximately **60 minutes to 75 minutes**.

Facilities:

Accessible facilities are available onsite, throughout the venue.

- Public toilets and meeting spaces are available onsite.
- Wheelchair accessible entry and room access (please confirm the most suitable entry point and room location with the venue ahead of time).
- Assistance animals are welcome.
