

Accessibility Information | Romsey Community Hub Drop-In

Location:

Romsey Community Hub
96-100 Main Street
Romsey VIC 3434

The venue is accessible via the Calder Freeway and Melbourne-Lancefield Road. It is a 50 to 60 minute drive from Melbourne's CBD.

Parking:

Parking is available to the left-hand side of the venue, or along Market Street (one way). Time limits apply.

Public transport:

Romsey Community Hub is accessible via regional bus connections.

- **V/Line services:** Operate between Melbourne's Southern Cross Station and Gisborne, Riddells Creek and Sunbury station.
- **Bus:** Routes 73 and 74 serve the Romsey area.

PTV travel time from Melbourne CBD is approximately 1 hour 15 minutes to 1 hour and 40 minutes.

Facilities:

Accessible facilities are available onsite, throughout the venue.

- Romsey Community Hub features accessible entry, accessible parking, accessible toilets, and meeting rooms.
- Accessible main entrance with wide entry points throughout the building.
- Accessible pathways suitable for wheelchairs and mobility aids.
- Accessible toilets available on-site.
