



# Updated: monthly update – Princes Highway, President Avenue and West Botany Street

## M6 Stage 1

September 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Bidjigal, Dharawal, Gweagal and Gadigal clans of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

M6 Stage 1 will connect President Avenue at Kogarah to the M8 at Arncliffe via a four-kilometre tunnel, linking southern Sydney to the wider motorway network.

### What work are we doing?

Ongoing roadwork and utility upgrades will continue during September along President Avenue, Princes Highway, West Botany Street, and in our Rockdale Bicentennial Park and Motorway Operation Centre (MOC3).

### When and where we'll be working

Our standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm, Saturday.

We are approved to work out-of-hours from 6pm to 7am, for up to three weeknights per week, no more than two consecutive weeknights and a maximum of 10 nights per month per zone.

Planned out-of-hours work dates and locations are shown in the table and map overleaf. Out of hours contingency dates have been scheduled in case work is cancelled due to wet weather.

All work is subject to fair weather. For the most up to date information, scan the QR code to visit the online portal.

### What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers, vehicles and truck movements
- temporary road closures and reduced speed limits on approach and at work areas
- pedestrian and cyclist closures or detours, with traffic controllers on site to guide you
- boom gates, concrete barriers and stop-slow traffic management.

Please follow the direction of signage and traffic control personnel (traffic set up may extend beyond work area).

### Managing our impacts

Properties near our work areas will experience noise and vibration, particularly during certain activities such as rock breaking, piling activities and vibratory rolling.

We regularly monitor noise, dust, and vibration near our sites and ensure appropriate mitigation measures are in place, this includes but is not limited to:

- installing temporary fencing with noise blankets, using non-tonal movement alarms and noise control kits
- pausing high impact noise and vibration activities every three hours to provide respite.

## October and November out of hours work

- Continuing finishing works, including kerbs, gutters, shared path, pavement, new medians, line marking and asphaltting work along President Avenue, Princes Highway and West Botany Street.
- Continuing intelligent traffic systems signs and signals work, as well as installing traffic lights at Lachal Avenue and Moorefield Avenue.
- Ongoing construction activities for the shared pedestrian and cyclist pathway, tunnel portal and MOC3.

- Temporary local traffic changes are in place, including no right turn from Moorefield Estate onto President Avenue, and Civic Avenue is now permanently left-in from President Avenue only. The following additional changes are planned for Q3 2025. We will notify you in advance:

- Lachal Avenue** will become one way southbound only. New traffic signals and a median slip lane will allow for safer right-in turn from President Avenue.
- Traynor Avenue** will become one way northbound between President and Annette Avenue, with left-out only onto President Avenue. **This change is at Council's request after provisional community consultation.**

**Temporary pedestrian changes are in place until Monday 6 October.** Footpath access on President Avenue between West Botany Street and O'Connell Street is only available along the southern side. To safely access this footpath, please use the existing signalised pedestrian crossings at West Botany Street and O'Connell Street on President Avenue.
