



Traffic delays due to night work on Putty Road, Glenridding

Singleton Bypass

June 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wonnarua/Wanaruah people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

As part of construction activities for the Singleton Bypass, traffic on Putty Road (near Carrington Street) and will be delayed during the night of **Monday 2 June 2025 and Tuesday 3 June 2025**.

What work are we doing?

The night work will involve installing seven girders on a new bridge which will form part of the bypass. The bridge crosses Putty Road and is 450 meters south of the Great Northern Railway line. Each girder is 33 meters in length and weighs 83 tonnes.

When and where we'll be working

To minimise traffic impact, work will be carried out on **Monday 2 June and Tuesday 3 June** between **7pm and 5am**, weather permitting. Work will be carried out on Putty Road near Carrington Street, Glenridding, approximately one kilometre south of Singleton CBD.

What will this mean for you?

To ensure the installation is carried out safely, traffic control will **stop traffic in both directions** on Putty Road at intervals throughout the night for up to **20 minutes**.

The traffic delays will occur from **7pm until 4am**.

Pedestrians and cyclists will be stopped by traffic control while the girder lifts and installation are underway.

Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be positioned along Putty Road and John Street and on sideroads to advise motorists. Live Traffic updates will also be issued.

We have included a map to show you the work location and traffic arrangements.

These activities have been assessed as having a moderate noise impact, with the following equipment used:

- lighting towers and generators
- 600 tonne crawler crane
- light vehicles and traffic control.

Motorists are advised to follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

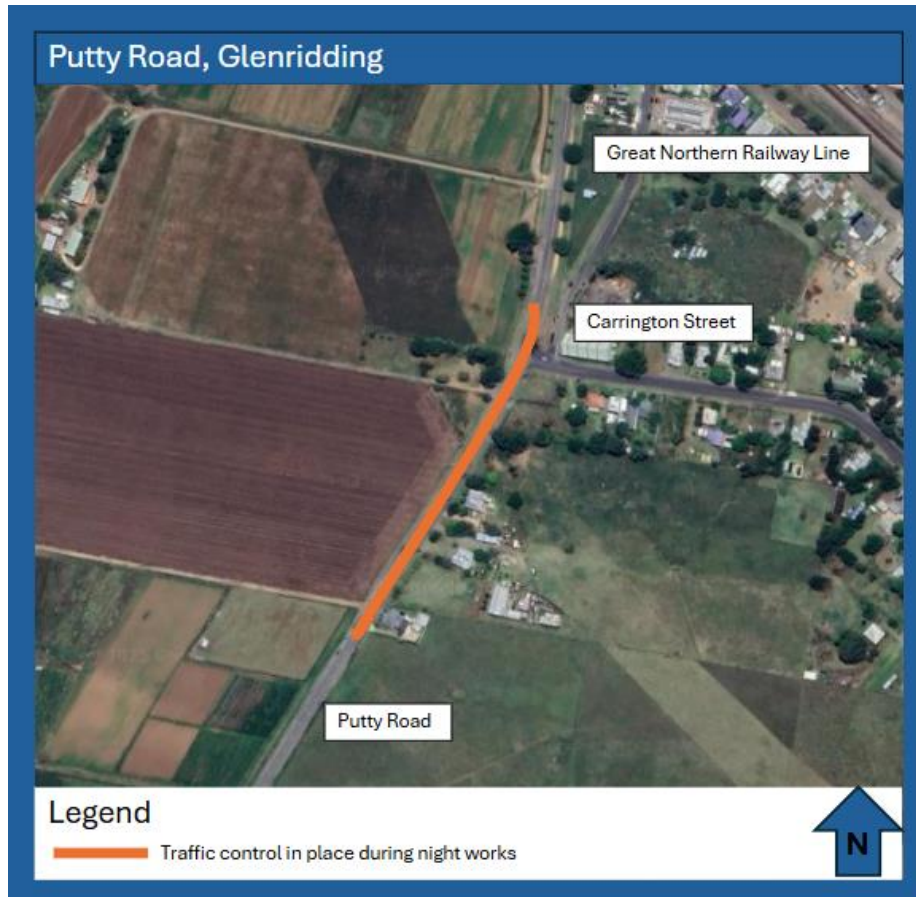
Looking ahead
