These hats are important for keeping people safe. They are helmets that protect our head from falling objects or bumps, preventing serious injury. They can also protect us from the sun. Sometimes you will see different coloured hard hats which helps improve safety by making it easy to identify

workers' roles quickly, especially in emergencies. For example, on the Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 3 project, a white hat represents a safety warden.

So, next time you see someone wearing a hard hat, you'll know it's not just to look good—it's to keep them safe and sound!

Print this hard hat on card or paper in A4 size



Create your design, then colour, paint or glue things (use card for this option) to your hard hat



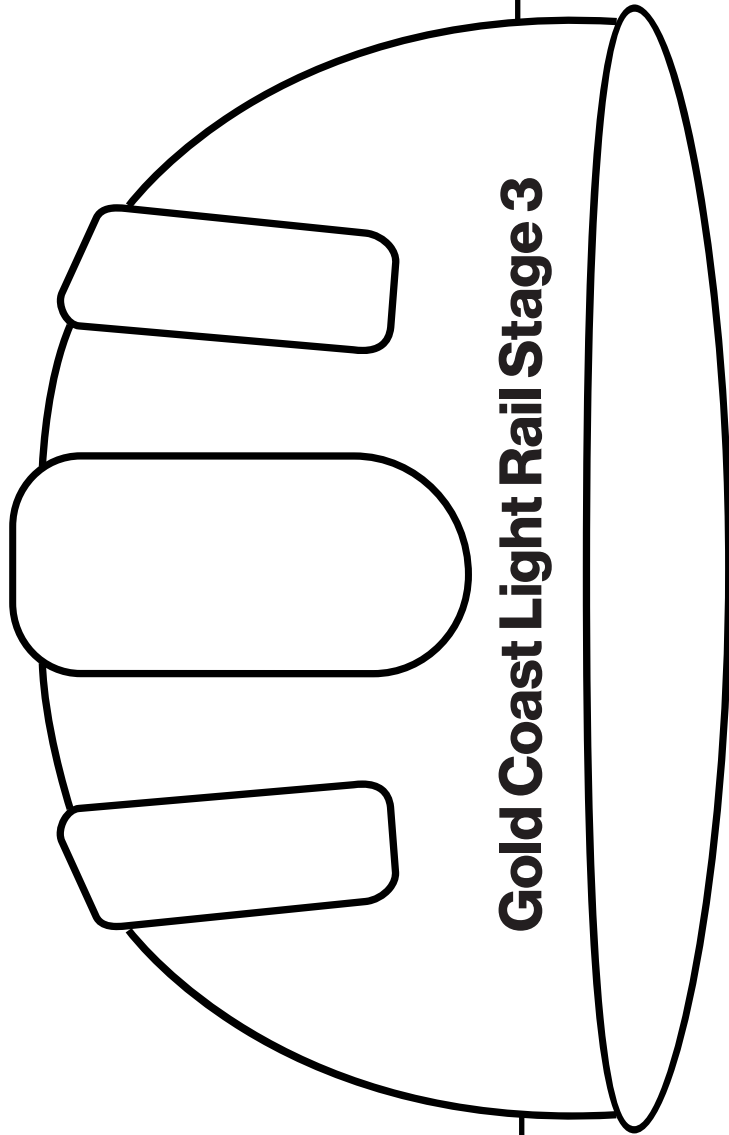
Cut out all three pieces



Glue or tape side pieces to the main hard hat



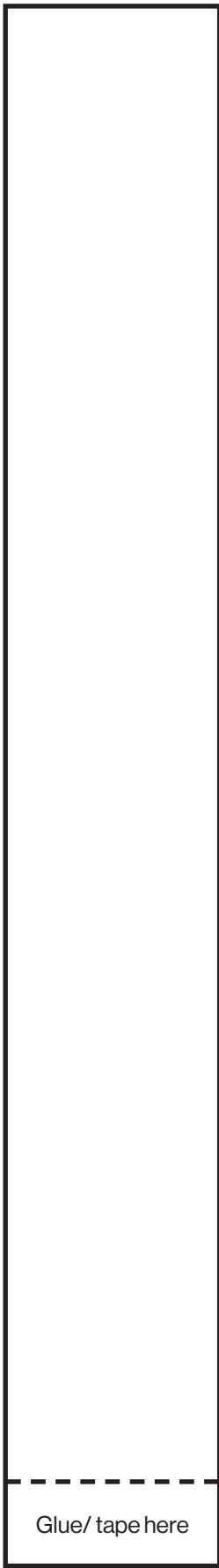
Wrap around the head and cut off any excess to fit your head. Glue or tape the ends closed.



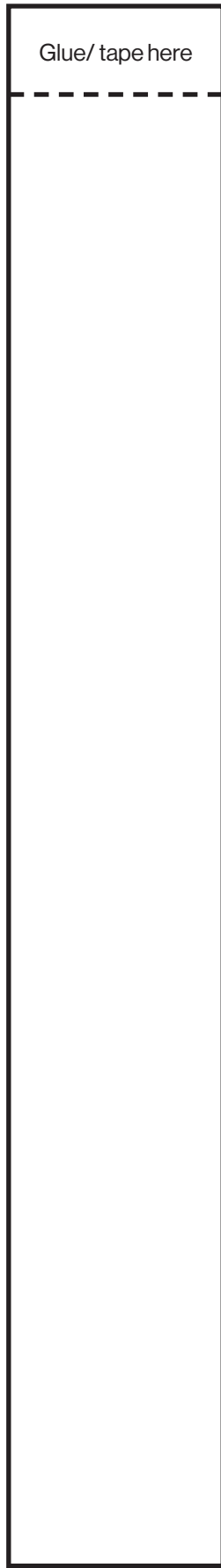
Main crown piece
