



Work notification | Berrys Bay foreshore parkland

Western Harbour Tunnel

January to June 2026

Western Harbour Tunnel (WHT) is a major transport infrastructure project that will make it easier, faster and safer to get around Sydney.

WHT including Berrys Bay foreshore parkland in Waverton, is being delivered by Transport for NSW and delivery partner ACCIONA. We are committed to reconnecting people to the history, land and waters at Berrys Bay through the delivery of a new foreshore parkland.

We appreciate your patience as we finalise plans to reimagine Woodley's Shed and integrate new community spaces into the parkland design.

What work are we doing?

Continuing over the next six months, weather and ground conditions permitting, our construction activities include:

- earthworks (including ground remediation work) and roadworks within the site boundary
- removing stones to create openings within the existing bund wall (we will salvage materials for reuse)
- removing vegetation including trees and installing tree protection zones
- installing, relocating and connecting utilities (e.g. power, water, stormwater and communications) using both trenching and vacuum excavation methods
- installing retaining walls and rainwater runoff drainage system (also known as a bioswale)
- delivering machinery, equipment and materials to and from the site.

Work within the water includes:

- maintaining the silt curtain, by boat
- demolishing the existing sea walls, removing materials by land and by barge, reconstructing new sea walls
- marine investigations, by barge.

What will this mean for you?

Our work includes the use of machinery and equipment such as:

- water blasters and vacuum trucks
- earthmoving equipment (like rollers, trucks, graders, dump trucks)
- excavators (with hammer attachment, if required)
- mobile cranes and crane trucks
- large work vehicles and elevated work platforms
- generators, power and hand tools.

We will aim to minimise the impact on you by:

- fitting our equipment with devices to reduce noise
- use traffic control with signs to assist large deliveries safely
- monitoring our work activities.
