

Works notification #88 | March 2024 | Broadbeach

Broadbeach South station works

John Holland will undertake works to connect the Stage 3 light rail tracks into the existing light rail network from 3 March 2024 to late 2024. Parts of the existing station at Broadbeach South station will be demolished so new track can be installed.

Works include

Phase 1 - Site establishment

- Establishing a construction zone with fencing and barriers at Broadbeach South station
- Site investigation and preparation works to confirm the location of existing underground services.

Phase 4 - Rail works

- Demolition of existing track infrastructure within the work area
- Construction of new overhead poles, cables, concrete track slab and rail.

What to expect

- Increase in noise and vibration associated with the use of heavy machinery including saw-cutting, jack hammering, concrete works, non-destructive digging and installing utility infrastructure
- Some **night works** are required in this area when trams are not running. These activities will **commence from 10pm**
- Changes to boarding and exiting trams. Wayfinding signage will be in place to direct pedestrian movements
- Relocated public amenities (view the map for the location)
- Temporary closure of one left hand turn lane into Hooker Boulevard
- Changes to pedestrian movements at Broadbeach South station.

Timing

Day works will be carried out between 6.30am and 6.30pm, Monday to Friday

Night works* will be carried out between 6.30pm and 6.30am, each night from Sunday night to Friday morning.

*Night works will be required at times. Advanced notification to confirm dates and times will be provided to directly impacted stakeholders via email updates.

No works will occur on public holidays unless otherwise notified.

Wet weather or unforeseen circumstances may result in changes to the work schedule.
