



# Upcoming nightworks on President Avenue

## M6 Stage 1

April 2026



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Bidjigal, Dharawal, Gweagal and Gadigal clans of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

With major work for the M6 Stage 1 project's surface works now complete, we are completing minor finishing works.

### When and where we'll be working

Our standard work hours are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm, Saturday**. We are approved to work out-of-hours from **6pm to 7am**, for up to three weeknights per week, no more than two consecutive weeknights and a maximum of 10 nights per month.

Due to road authority restrictions, this work must be undertaken outside of standard working hours.

Out-of-hours work is scheduled to take place between **Monday 13 April and Thursday 30 April 2026**, on the following nights: **13, 14, 16, 20, 21, 23, 27, 28 and 30 April**.

If work is delayed due to weather or site conditions, it will be carried out on the next available night shift.

This work will take place on **President Avenue between Princes Highway and Cross Street**. Please refer to map overleaf for further location details.

### What work are we doing?

Works will include the following activities:

- Removal of columns and existing cables
- Vacuum truck trenching
- Running new cables
- Streetlighting pole installation preparation.

### What will this mean for you?

Lane closures around the work zone, and pedestrian diversions may be in place to facilitate works. Please follow our traffic signs and the directions of traffic control. Traffic management will be in place to ensure the safety of workers and the community when working on or near live traffic.

The works may generate dust and moderate noise levels. We will manage dust directly at the source using water spray and manage noise by using squawkers instead of beepers on vehicles. Equipment and vehicles will be turned off when they are not being used. We use noise and dust monitoring to measure our impact to the local community.

Respite for one hour will occur every three hours during high impact activities.


Across the next three months, we are expecting to continue to conduct rectification work on an ad hoc basis. Consistent with works undertaken to date, this work may occur up to three weeknights per week, no more than two consecutive weeknights and a maximum of 10 nights per month. Work dates will be announced closer to the time of work
