Transport for NSW is investigating potential road safety improvements within and around the Western Sydney Airport Precinct.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will carry out day and night investigation work around the following intersections:

- Elizabeth Drive and Luddenham Road
- Elizabeth Drive and Mamre Road
- Mamre Road and Kerrs Road
- Devonshire Road and Cross Street
- Cowpasture Road intersections with
 - Fifteenth Avenue and Hoxton Park
 Road
 - Qantas Boulevard and Collarenebri Road
 - o Westlink M7

A work location map is provided overleaf.

Our work will involve:

- land survey
- utility and geotechnical investigations
- pavement coring and test pits

This may involve the use of light vehicles, a track mounted drilling rig, small excavator, vacuum truck, small haulage truck, survey equipment, testing and scanning equipment, lighting towers and small hand tools to complete this work.

When and where we'll be working

We will be onsite from 18 June 2024 to 31 July 2024, weather permitting.

Our working hours will be from **8am to 6pm**, **Monday to Friday**. Our night shift hours would be between **8pm and 7am** from **Sunday to Thursday** and we will work up to three night shifts at each location, weather permitting.

We will not work on public holidays.

What will this mean for you?

There will be temporary traffic changes such as shoulder and partial lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the directions of traffic control and signs.

You may also notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Noise from machinery and equipment.


Managing our impacts

Our work may generate some low-level noise. We will do everything we can to minimise disruption, including:

- Switching off vehicles/machinery when not in use
- Reminding workers to minimise unnecessary noise
- Directing lighting towers away from properties when working at night.
