Ongoing construction of the shared pedestrian and cyclist pathway from Civic Avenue to Chuter Avenue

M6 Stage 1

As part of the M6 Stage 1 project, construction of the shared pedestrian and cyclist pathway continues in May.

Once the pathways are constructed, there will be renewed natural landscapes, green spaces, and recreational facilities for the community to enjoy.

When and where we'll be working

Work continues between Civic Avenue and Chuter Avenue through Scarborough Park. Our standard work hours are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm, Saturday.**

Our approved out-of-hours are from **6pm to 7am**, **Monday to Friday**.

Our upcoming out-of-hours work dates are:

- Monday 29 April
- Wednesday 1 May
- Thursday 16 May.

Dates and timing of work are subject to change depending on weather and site conditions.

What work are we doing?

Our day work will include:

- construction of the pedestrian bridge, including excavating and pouring concrete for the spiral ramp on President Avenue
- building temporary foundations to support large plant equipment, including piling rigs

- upgrading drainage in Scarborough Park
- excavating for underground utilities, for light pole footings for future pathway lighting
- delivery of materials, such as gravel, sandstone, concrete, reinforcement, ongoing earthworks, and vegetation removal
- delivery of precast piles to site via Chuter Avenue and Civic Avenue site entries
- installing piles for the foundation of Scarborough Park boardwalks
- maintaining environmental controls to manage erosion and sediment, as well as dust and noise mitigation.

Our night work will include:

- pouring concrete for the spiral ramp on President Avenue
- delivery and removal of the oversized plant machinery from Chuter Avenue and Civic Avenue site entries.

Our equipment includes excavators, cranes, piling rigs, tippers, telehandler, mulcher, stump grinder, concrete pumps, concrete trucks, concrete saws, compactors, rollers, lighting towers, hand tools, trucks and light vehicles, such as utes.

Community Agreement outcome

We recently consulted the community to work outside of our standard construction hours to facilitate pouring concrete for the spiral ramp on

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President Avenue. This resulted with a substantial majority in favour of the proposal.

The work is scheduled to proceed over two days, Wednesday 1 May and Thursday 16 May, between 6pm and 12am, weather permitting.

What will this mean for you?

The footpath in Scarborough Park (from Civic Avenue to Chuter Avenue) remains closed throughout 2024. Access to Scarborough Park and Civic Reserve is maintained through alternate entrances on Civic Avenue near the intersection of Marshall Street and south of the intersection at Annette Street, as well as on Chuter Avenue near the intersection of Robinson Street.

Temporary lane closures on President Avenue and in Chuter Avenue may occur during the delivery and relocation of the oversized plant machinery. Oversized plant will be moved to-and-from site during nightshift, in-line with road safety plans.

The pedestrian pathway on the southern side of President Avenue remains temporarily closed with pedestrian and cyclist access available on the northern side.

Managing our impacts

We will manage dust by using a water cart and manage noise by using squawkers instead of beepers on vehicles. We'll turn off equipment and vehicles when they are not being used. We use noise and dust monitoring to measure our impact to the local community.

Respite for one hour will occur every three hours during high impact day activities (this will usually be at 11am and 3pm Monday to Friday and at 11am on Saturday).



Location of work area

Work area – no pedestrian access — Future shared pedestrian and cyclist pathway alignment = Site entry/exit. Construction vehicles and personnel only.
