

Burleigh works: Step two

Gold Coast Highway, Burleigh Heads Connor Street to West Burleigh Road

Step two works in the Burleigh Heads business centre will commence from Monday 10 July. This notification provides information about step two works which have been scheduled during the quieter period of the year for business trade. Works include

Electricity shopfront trenching

- This involves saw cutting, non-destructive digging, and installing electrical pipes
- Note: Energex will then install new aboveground electricity pillars to prepare properties for new electrical connections and to remove existing aboveground power poles and powerlines.

Electricity pit construction

- Removing existing street infrastructure and installing fixed fencing around the work area (see map overleaf)
- Saw cutting, excavating and installing trenching support boxes
- Installing steel, timber formwork, and concreting works to build the pit.

Electricity underground road crossing

- Saw cutting and trenchless excavating (horizontal directional drilling (HDD) - to find out more about HDD, visit the 'Constructing GCLR3' page).

What to expect

- Increase in construction activity including noise, vibration, and vehicle movements within and near to the works area. Every effort will be taken to minimise impacts
- Temporary changes to roadside dining for businesses. Businesses will be contacted directly to discuss the required changes.

Traffic changes

Parking

- Permanent closure of on-street parking from Monday 10 July on the northbound side of the Gold Coast Highway between Connor Street and West Street, Burleigh Heads.

- Changes to signed parking for selected parking bays on Connor Street and the Gold Coast Highway between 1740 Gold Coast Highway and West Street.

Pedestrians and access

- Access to businesses and properties will be maintained with reduced footpath width.

Traffic

- Overnight laneway closures of the Gold Coast Highway exit point of Justin Lane are required to complete works across the laneway. Further information will be provided prior to any closures taking place.

Timing

Electricity shopfront trenching

- From **Monday 10 July** for up to six weeks
- 9.30pm to 6.30am, each night from Sunday night to Friday morning
- Works will be completed in small sections, with each area required two to three weeks to complete.

Electricity pit construction

- From **early August 2023** for up to eight weeks
- 8pm to 6.30am, each night from Sunday night to Friday morning.

Electricity underground road crossing

- From **early-September 2023 for up to two weeks** for up to four weeks.

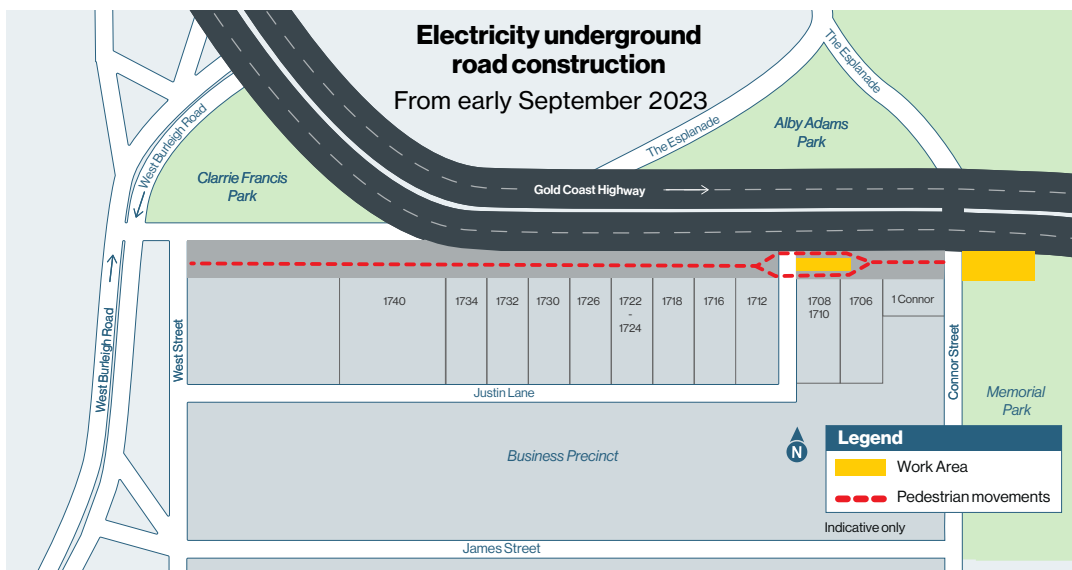
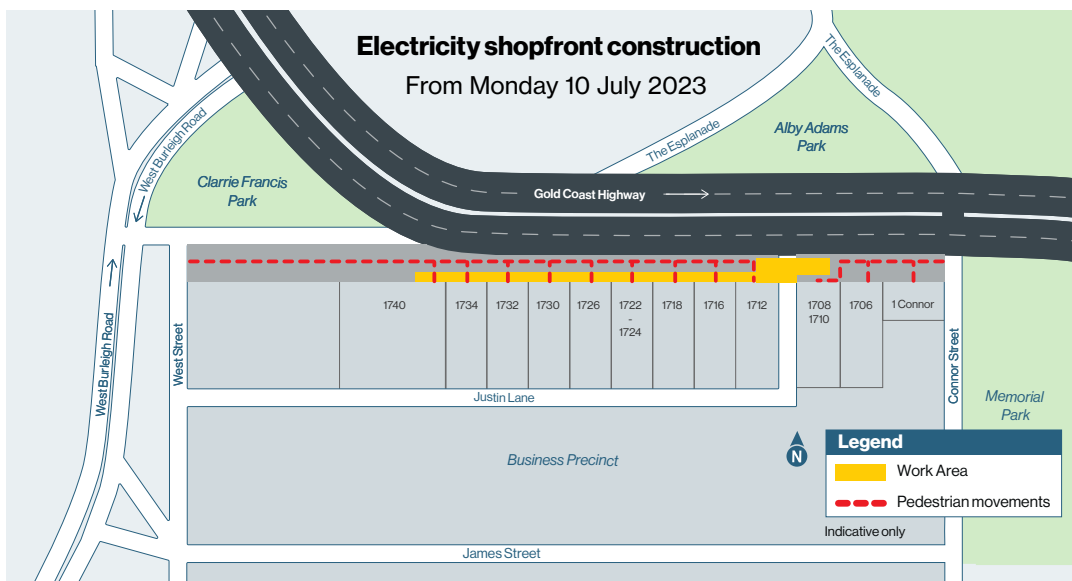
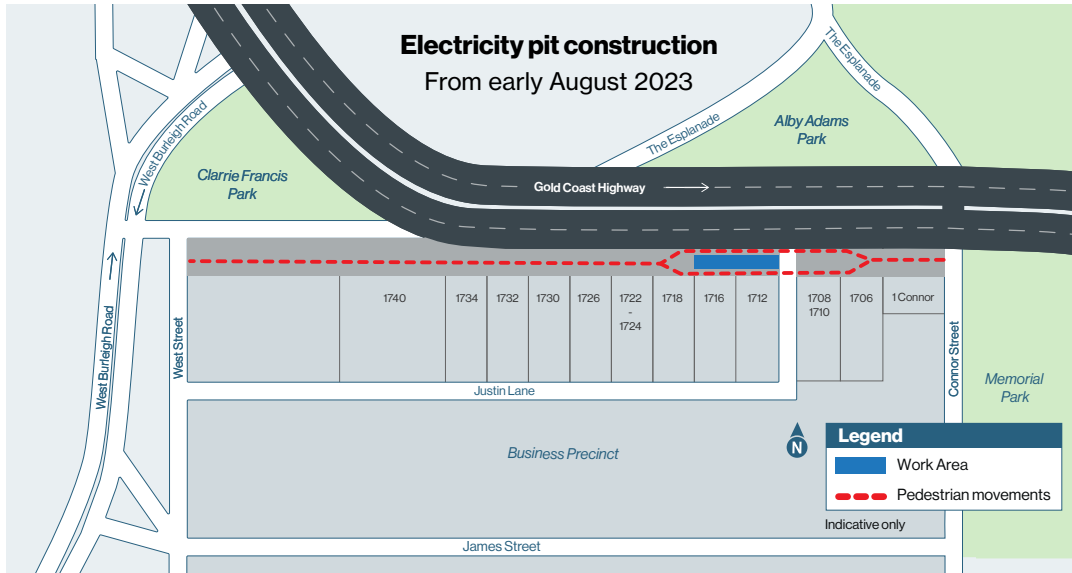
No works will occur on public holidays unless otherwise notified. Wet weather or unforeseen circumstances may result in changes to the work schedule.
