# 11kV Feeder Power Upgrade

Works Update

## Dear Neighbour

The NSW Government is delivering a new Sydney Fish Market which will retain its authentic experience and strengthen its position as one of Australia's leading tourist destinations.

Multiplex is currently undertaking works to upgrade the power supply for the new Sydney Fish Market. This work involves trenching and installing conduit and cabling along a 1.8km route from Lyons Road in Camperdown to the site in Bridge Road, Glebe (see map over the page).

# Works update: fortnight commencing Sunday 28 August 2022

Upcoming night works will include saw cutting the top layer of pavement, followed by trenching, duct installation and temporary pavement restoration. To minimise community impacts, noisier works will be undertaken prior to 12:00am and work will be undertaken in each zone for a maximum of two nights per week (see zoned map below).



Thu 8 Sept	Night works 6pm-5am	Zone 3 – between Gottenham Ln & Railway St

Please note work schedules may change due to weather, conditions, and authority approvals.



#### Location of Work

The approximate location of work zones over the coming fortnight is indicated on the map below. *Note: This is an approximate representation and work zones are subject to change without notice.* 



#### Hours of work

Working hours will be mainly at night between 6:00pm to 5:00am, Sunday to Friday. Works are being undertaken at night to minimise the impact on traffic and pedestrian movement.

## What to expect

Work zones will be fenced off, with traffic control in place to safely guide vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians around the work zone. Regular traffic conditions and pedestrian access will be restored at the end of each shift.

Bus routes will be maintained with limited relocation of bus stops around work zones when necessary.

Some kerbside parking spaces may be unavailable during the work however driveway access will be maintained.

We understand the potential impacts this may cause to the local community and thank you for your understanding during this work.

All required road occupancy licences, permits and approvals have been granted.
