Work Notification | Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) installation work in Rozelle, Lilyfield and Annandale

Western Harbour Tunnel November 2025

Western Harbour Tunnel is a major transport infrastructure project that will make it easier, faster and safer to get around Sydney.

The project is preparing to install an Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) network around the Western Harbour Tunnel (WHT) entry and exit portals in City West Link, Rozelle.

These systems provide real time information and advanced warning to drivers using the road network and will be critical for the safe and efficient operation of Western Harbour Tunnel when it opens to traffic in 2028.

What you need to know

We will be working in City West Link, Rozelle and Lilyfield, and The Crescent and Johnston Street, Annandale, during the day and night over the school holiday period.

Our work includes:

- setting up temporary work areas in City West Link,
 The Cresent and Johnston Street
- · digging trenches and cable pits
- pouring concrete foundations for variable message signs (VMS) and other ITS equipment
- reinstating the road and pavement surfaces when our work is complete.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working at six locations shown on the map overleaf.

From **Saturday 27 December**, we will be working for up to four weeks during our approved construction hours.

This is to carry out the bulk of our work during the day while traffic volumes are low.

We will not work on public holidays.

Night work will be carried out on **Mondays, Tuesdays** and **Thursdays** throughout this period.

If we cannot work these nights, we will work on Wednesdays and Fridays instead.

Noisy work will occur no more than 10 nights per calendar month, three nights per week and no more than two nights in a row.

From Saturday 27 December 2025 for up to four weeks until 24 January 2026



Hours of operation

Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm Saturday and Sunday from 8am to 6pm

Night work:

Monday, Tuesday & Thursday from 9pm to 7am Saturday and Sunday from 9pm to 6am We will notify you in advance if we need to work on any additional nights.

Night work will continue after the school holiday period to complete the ITS installation. This will be done in line with our project approvals, and we will notify you in advance.

Traffic impacts

This work will require temporary traffic changes including partial road closures, lane closures, and detours for walking and cycling.

We will set up traffic control measures around our work sites to ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians and our workers.

Please follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Access around our sites will be provided for pedestrians and cyclists throughout this work.

Please note there may be additional road closures on the network over the school holiday period. Go to Live Traffic for the latest traffic information and to plan your journey.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- · traffic controllers and signs
- road closures and reduced speed limits
- walking and cycling path detours with traffic controllers to guide you
- noise from machines and equipment.

Managing our impact

Our work includes the use of machinery and equipment such as:


- saw cutters
- water blasters and vacuum trucks
- asphalt pavers, drum rollers and plate compactors
- elevated work platforms

- traffic control devices
- temporary lighting towers
- large work vehicles
- rigid, asphalt and concrete delivery trucks
- piling and excavation equipment
- crane trucks and mobile cranes
- line marking scrubbers
- power and hand tools.

We will aim to minimise the impact on you by:

- fitting our equipment with devices to reduce noise
- having traffic control and signs around our work area
- · monitoring our work activities.
