

Work on Elizabeth Drive, Wallgrove Road, Cecil Road in Cecil Park, and the M7 Motorway

M7-M12 Integration project

December 2024



We acknowledge the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The M7-M12 Integration project will support future development growth in Western Sydney by improving travel times and congestion. Once complete, the project will provide direct access to commercial and residential hubs, and the new Western Sydney International Airport.

What work are we doing?

We will be working along Elizabeth Drive, Wallgrove Road, the realigned Wallgrove Road, and Cecil Road in Cecil Park and Cecil Hills. We will also be working along the M7 Motorway, including ramps and in the adjacent M7 shared path between the M5 Motorway, Prestons and Richmond Road, Oakhurst/Glendenning. We will work between **Monday 2 December** and **Friday 20 December 2024**, weather permitting.

Our work includes:

- geotechnical and environmental investigations and assessments
- installing erosion and sediment controls
- stormwater drainage, culvert and fauna crossing construction
- construction of retaining walls and bridge abutment including shotcreting and sandblasting concrete
- utilities investigation, installation and relocation
- inspecting roads and traffic assessments
- vegetation clearing and removal of topsoil

- relocating, installing and upgrading traffic lights including control systems along the Elizabeth Drive Connection (EDC)
- pavement and haul road construction, road resurfacing, asphalt placement and line marking
- bridge work including piling, formwork, bridge deck construction and concrete pours across all bridges including at the M7-M12 Interchange and EDC
- installing, adjusting and removal of safety barriers
- temporary work including building piling pads and creek crossings for machinery and site access and installation of fencing and hoarding
- delivery of machinery, equipment and materials to site compounds and project areas
- bulk earthworks, including excavation and hauling of materials
- pavement works along M7 mainline within the median.

Our work schedule

Standard work hours are between **7am** and **6pm**, **Monday** to **Friday** and between **8am** and **6pm** on **Saturdays**.

Out-of-hours work hours are **6pm** to **7am**, **Monday** to **Friday** and **6pm Friday** to **8am Saturday morning**. Work may occur outside of these hours, subject to additional approval. We will not complete noisy work more than two nights in a row and three nights in a week or ten nights in a month in the same location. There will be no work on public holidays.







End of year shutdown

The project will be closed over the holiday period. All work areas and site offices will close from **5pm Friday 20 December 2024** to **7am on Monday 6 January 2025.**

What equipment will be used?

We will be using vacuum trucks, specialised ground penetrating equipment, cranes and lifting equipment, elevated work platforms, saws, excavators, mulchers, compactors, watercarts, profilers, sweepers, light and heavy vehicles, lighting towers, saws, dozers, scrapers, slashers, vibratory rollers, pumps and generators, line marking trucks, water blasting machines, piling and soil nail rigs, hand and power tools, concrete trucks and pumps, paver, hydraulic launch system, bridge launch noses, rattle guns, grinders, traffic control, concrete sandblast machine, trenchers, air compressors and hydro demolition equipment.

What will this mean for you?

There will be temporary traffic changes including lane, ramp and road closures, detours and reduced speed limits near our work and nearby local roads. Traffic lanes will be temporarily realigned at the EDC. Road users will be notified of temporary traffic changes via variable messaging signs and on-site signage.

The speed limit on the M7 Motorway has now been reduced to 80km/h between the M5 Motorway, Prestons and Richmond Road, Oakhurst/Glendenning. This speed reduction will remain in place until project completion in 2026.

For safety reasons, during construction bike riders are not permitted on the M7 Motorway. There will be reduced widths and temporary closures along sections of the M7 Motorway shared user path. Signage will be installed advising bike riders and pedestrians of changes.

Managing our impacts

Some work close to residential areas may be noisy. We will minimise noise by scheduling any noisy work earlier in the evening, switching off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Help us plan for future night work


For the safety of drivers, pedestrians and our workers, some work will need to take place at night. Some activities close to residential areas may be noisy. Impacted residents will be notified separately.

We invite your feedback on how this may affect you and what we can do to minimise our impacts.

Please note, noise levels and their impacts are subject to the location and distance of the property from the work site. Some of this work will be moderate to noisy and be similar to either a washing machine or a vacuum cleaner.
