

Work on Elizabeth Drive, Wallgrove Road, Cecil Road in Cecil Park, and the M7 Motorway

M7-M12 Integration project

April 2024

We acknowledge the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The M7-M12 Integration project will support future development growth in Western Sydney by improving travel times and congestion. Once complete, the project will provide direct access to commercial and residential hubs, and the new Western Sydney International Airport.

What work are we doing?

We will be working at the Elizabeth Drive Connection (EDC), including along Elizabeth Drive, Wallgrove Road, the realigned Wallgrove Road, and Cecil Road in Cecil Park and Cecil Hills. We will also be working along the M7 Motorway, including ramps and in the adjacent M7 shared path between the M5 Motorway, Prestons and Richmond Road, Oakhurst/Glendenning. We will work between **Tuesday 2 April** and **Tuesday 30 April 2024** weather permitting.

Our work includes:

- geotechnical and environmental investigations and assessments
- installing erosion and sediment controls
- stormwater drainage, culvert and fauna crossing construction
- identifying environmentally sensitive areas

- utilities investigation, installation and relocation (we will notify you in advance if this work will cause any service disruptions)
- inspecting roads, including condition surveys and traffic assessments
- relocating, installing and upgrading traffic lights including control systems along the EDC
- continuing vegetation clearing and removing of topsoil
- road resurfacing, asphalt placement and pavement construction
- bridge foundation work including piling, formwork and concrete pours across all bridges
- construction of retaining walls at EDC and under the M7 Motorway bridges
- removing of existing and installation of temporary traffic signage and line marking
- installing, adjusting and removal of safety barriers
- establishing site compounds and work areas
- delivery of machinery, equipment and materials to site compounds and project areas
- bulk earthworks, including excavation and hauling of materials
- ongoing concrete pours to support construction activities along the M7 Motorway and EDC area
- shared path under the M7 Motorway bridge closure at Reedy Creek from April to May.

The following M7 widening works will continue:

- traffic lane realignment, including reducing lane widths, line removal and marking
- wire rope barrier removal and installation of temporary barriers
- installing safety barriers along the M7 Motorway to establish work zones within the median
- site establishment including removal of topsoil, installation of access gates, temporary pavement and access road within the median
- tree clearing within the median
- building temporary creek crossings under the M7 Motorway for machinery and site access
- delivery of machinery, equipment and materials to site compounds within median
- modifications and protection works of the existing drainage infrastructure within median
- installation of new drainage and stormwater alignment
- removal of existing static and electronic traffic signs
- bridge foundation work including site establishment, piling, formwork and concrete pours for bridges located at Hoxton Park Road, Villiers Road, Angus Creek, Aviation Road, Hinchinbrook Creek, Future Access Road, Maxwell Creek, Benera Road and Reedy Creek.

Help us plan for future night work

For the safety of drivers, pedestrians and our workers, some work will need to take place at night. Some activities close to residential areas may be noisy. Impacted residents will be notified separately.

We invite your feedback on how this may affect you and what we can do to minimise our impacts.

Our work schedule

Standard work hours are between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday and between 8am and 6pm on Saturdays.

Our out of hours work hours are **6pm** to **7am**, **Monday** to **Friday morning** and **6pm Friday** to **8am Saturday morning**. There will be no work on public holidays. We will not complete noisy work more than two (2) nights in a row and three (3) nights in a week or ten (10) nights in a month in the same location. Work may occur outside of these hours, subject to additional approval.

What equipment will be used?

We will be using vacuum excavation trucks, road saws, specialised ground penetrating equipment, cranes and lifting equipment, elevated work platforms, chainsaws, excavators, mulchers, compactors, watercarts, profilers, sweepers, light and heavy vehicles, lighting towers, saws, dozers, scrapers, slashers, vibratory rollers, pump and generators, line marking trucks, water blasting machines, piling rigs, hand tools, power tools, concrete trucks/ agitators, concrete pumps, concrete vibrators, asphalt paver, asphalt profiler, franna crane and traffic control.

What will this mean for you?

There will be temporary traffic changes including lane and ramp closures, detours and reduced speed limits near our works and nearby local roads. Road users will be notified of temporary traffic changes.

The speed limit on the M7 Motorway has now been reduced to 80km/h where signposted. This speed reduction will remain in place until completion of the project in 2026.

For safety reasons during construction bike riders are not permitted on the M7 Motorway. There will be reduced widths and temporary closures along sections of the M7 Motorway shared user path. Signage will be installed advising bike riders and pedestrians of changes.

Some equipment will be delivered outside of our standard hours in line with Transport for NSW's requirements for moving oversized equipment and materials.

Some stopping bays and emergency phones will be removed along the M7 Motorway. Signs will be in place at remaining stopping bays for drivers requiring assistance. Please remain in your vehicle and call the M7-M12 Integration project Traffic Control Room on 02 9834 9621. This line is monitored 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Managing our impacts

During our work you will see an increase in activity in the area as workers move around the site. Some work close to residential areas may be noisy. We will take every possible step to minimise noise, such as scheduling any noisy work earlier in the evening during night work, switching off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.
