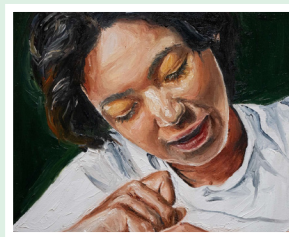

We are excited to announce that the annual Transurban Art Prize has returned for 2024 and is open to all students in years 7 – 10 in NSW.

Formerly known as the Canal to Creek Art Prize, this is an opportunity for students across all of NSW to create their own piece of art, inspired by our 2024 theme, 'connections'. At Transurban, we are proud to strengthen and connect communities through transport, so we want you to consider YOUR connections to people and place.

The Transurban Art Prize is open to students from Years 7 to 10, NSW wide.

- Artworks must be original and respond to the theme - 'Connections'.
- Artworks can be two-dimensional or three-dimensional (e.g. paintings, sculptures, digital).
- Any art material or combination of materials may be used.
- Artworks to be submitted in a JPG or PNG file, at least 1500 pixels wide.
- Artworks must have the ability to be digitally reproduced by Transurban for promotional purposes.
- Entries will need a title and an accompanying artist statement, limited to 100 words.
- A virtual interactive gallery will showcase all successful entries and be publicly available. For privacy reasons, only first name and school name will be published.
