Community benefit the focus of M6 Stage 1

With surface work restarting in July, the project is focused on completing upgrades to President Avenue and local roads by the end of 2025, along with the new shared pedestrian and cyclist pathway and extensive landscaping. This work will transform the local road network, deliver new walking and cycling routes and revive the environment.

Transforming the environment - new planting and landscaping

Work is forging ahead on the shared path for pedestrians and cyclists. It will feature four new bridges and over 366 metres of new boardwalk structures.

Landscaping is ongoing with trees including Eucalyptus and Paperbark and flowering shrubs such as Banksias and Bottlebrushes being planted along the path.

Roadworks on President Avenue are nearly complete. Final work has started on pavements and kerbs, with new asphalt, line marking and traffic signals. We will also be landscaping along President Avenue and West Botany Street, bringing a much welcomed refresh.
