



Monthly Update – Princes Highway, President Avenue and West Botany Street

M6 Stage 1

November 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Bidjigal, Dharawal, Gweagal and Gadigal clans of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

M6 Stage 1 will connect President Avenue at Kogarah to the M8 at Arncliffe via a four-kilometre tunnel, linking southern Sydney to the wider motorway network.

What work are we doing?

Roadwork and utility upgrades continue during November along President Avenue, Princes Highway, West Botany Street, Rockdale Bicentennial Park and Motorway Operation Centre (MOC3).

Finishing work such as landscaping has commenced, including in median islands and Council verges.

When and where we'll be working

Our standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm, Saturday.

We are approved to work out-of-hours from 6pm to 7am, for up to three weeknights per week, no more than two consecutive weeknights and a maximum of 10 nights per month per zone.

Planned out-of-hours work dates and locations are shown in the table and map overleaf. Out-of-hours work is scheduled to take place between Monday 3 and Friday 28 November, 2025. If work is delayed due to weather or site conditions, it will be carried out on the next available night shift.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers, vehicles and truck movements
- temporary road closures and reduced speed limits on approach and at work areas
- temporary pedestrian and cyclist closures or detours, with traffic controllers on site to guide you
- boom gates, concrete barriers and stop-slow traffic management.

Traffic set up may extend beyond our work areas. Please follow the direction of signage and traffic control personnel.

Managing our impacts

Properties near our work areas will experience noise and vibration, particularly during certain activities such as rock breaking, piling activities and vibratory rolling.

We regularly monitor noise, dust, and vibration near our sites and ensure appropriate mitigation measures are in place, this includes but is not limited to:

- installing temporary fencing with noise blankets, using non-tonal movement alarms and noise control kits
- pausing high impact noise and vibration activities every three hours to provide respite.

Zone A East	President Avenue between President Avenue bridge and Crawford Road • 5 and 6 November • 12 and 13 November • 19 and 20 November • 26 and 27 November	• Continuing finishing works, including kerbs, gutters, ACO drains, medians, landscaping and shared pathway. • Pavement level correction and reinstatement. • Pavement final wearing course and line markings. • Accessing the stormwater line and completing medians, line marking, footpath and asphaltting works at the O'Neill Street cul-de-sac. • Landscaping preparation, including removing and planting new vegetation. • Traffic signal adjustment at O'Connell Street. • Reinstating the cul-de-sac at Colson Crescent.

Zone East	President Avenue between Crawford Road and The Grand Parade • 5 and 6 November • 12 and 13 November • 19 and 20 November • 26 and 27 November	• Intelligent traffic systems signage and signal works. • Maintenance of pre-existing pile outside 177 President Avenue.
WBS and MOC3	West Botany Street between President Avenue and MOC3 • 3 and 4 November • 10 and 11 November • 17 and 18 November • 24 and 25 November	• Continuing finishing works, including kerbs, gutters, ACO drains, driveways, medians, landscaping, shared path, asphaltting, line marking. • Accessing and upgrading communication assets including conduit installation and piling works for future signals and signage. • Concrete placement, steel fixing and scaffold modification activities at MOC3. • Milling and resheeting for pavement restoration.
  	Bicentennial Park, O'Neill Street and Colson Crescent site compounds These sites can be accessed outside of standard construction hours and work dates.	• Continuing structural steel and cladding install for the tunnel portal. • Collecting and relocating stockpiled material, delivering and relocating equipment and oversized plant. • Ongoing utility investigations and monitoring, as required • Footpath and vegetation works at the O'Neill Street cul-de-sac. • Installing signposts and road furniture. • Stormwater drainage upgrades in Bicentennial Park, including removing hoarding and installing temporary fencing near the southern carpark. • Removing temporary haul roads and hardstand areas. • Excavating, installing underground conduits and piling to install lighting poles along the shared pathway. • Removal of the temporary boundary wall at Bicentennial Park East, and installation of temporary fencing. • Landscaping, earthworks (including the use of vibratory roller), vegetation and tree removal, and constructing retaining walls for the shared pathway. • Ongoing concrete works and drainage upgrades for the Bado Berong bridge, as well as dewatering within the tunnel portal and for the shared pathway. • Ongoing concrete works, welding, painting, scaffolding, and installing, handrails, and drainage pipes for President Avenue bridge.

December out of hours work

- Continuing finishing works such as kerbs, gutters, shared path, pavement, landscaping, new medians, line marking and asphaltting work along President Avenue, Princes Highway and West Botany Street.
- Continuing intelligent traffic systems signs and signals work.
- Ongoing construction activities for the shared pedestrian and cyclist pathway, tunnel portal and MOC3.

Permanent traffic and pedestrian changes

- Traffic lights have been installed at Lachal Avenue and are expected to be installed at Moorefield Avenue in November 2025.
- Traffic changes have been made in Traynor Avenue and Lachal Avenue.
- Footpath access on the northern side of President Avenue between West Botany Street and O'Connell Street has now been reopened.

Community Information Centre closing
