

A non-stop South Road

T2D → **TORRENS TO DARLINGTON**

Shared Use Path closure, West Hindmarsh

May 2026

The River Torrens to Darlington (T2D) Project is South Australia's largest infrastructure project and will create a non-stop South Road between Gawler and Old Noarlunga.

What's happening

Works are required along South Road between the River Torrens and Grange Road, including along the River Torrens/Karrawirra Parri to prepare for the construction of the new road bridge. The road bridge will form the northbound service road of South Road.

As a part of this work, we will also be constructing a new Shared Use Path on the southern side of the river, which will improve the east-west connectivity, and ultimate experience for active travel users.

The temporary closure of the River Torrens Linear Park Trail will commence from Monday 18 May for 6 months.

How this affects you

Temporary changes to pedestrian and cycling access

From Monday 18 May 2026 the River Torrens Linear Trail will be temporarily closed at the underpass between McDonnell Avenue and West Hindmarsh Cemetery. While construction is underway in this area a pedestrian and cyclist detour will be in place.

Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians and cyclists to the detour. Please see detour map below.

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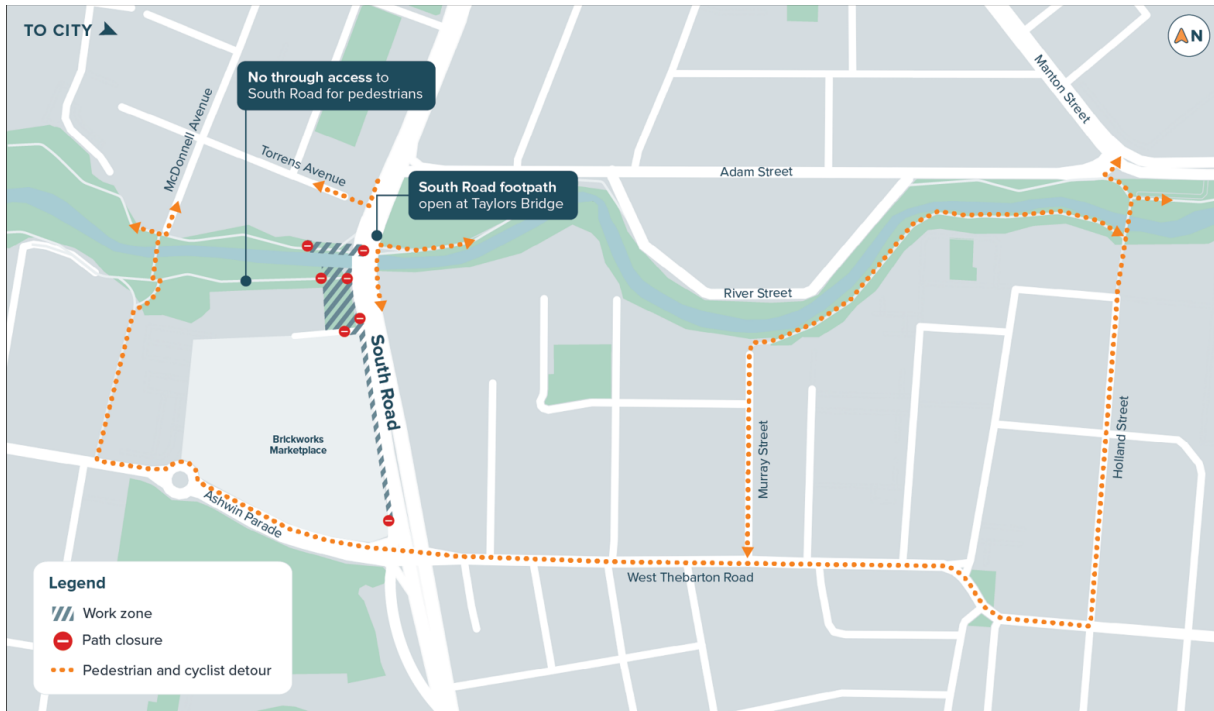
