Survey work and installation of survey markers at Arncliffe and Wollie Creek from Tuesday 12 October 2021

About the M6 Stage 1

The M6 Stage 1 will connect President Avenue at Kogarah to the M8 at Arncliffe via a four kilometre tunnel, linking southern Sydney to the wider motorway network.

Latest update

Between Tuesday 12 October and Friday 10 December, we will carry out survey work including installing survey markers at a number of road locations at Arncliffe and Wollie Creek. A map of our work area is shown over the page.

What does our work involve?

Our survey markers will monitor ground settlement before, during and after tunnelling work.

Our work will include:

- setting up tripods or survey poles to survey the road for suitable locations to install the survey markers
- installing the survey marker (a small metal prism or pin) which we will drill or glue onto the kerb or road.

Our work schedule

Our work will take up to eight weeks to complete, weather permitting. We will be at each location for around one hour.

Our standard construction work hours are:

- **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday**
- **8am to 1pm, Saturday**

How will our work affect you?

For the safety of our workers and the community, we will need to temporarily close some street parking and make some traffic changes during our work. Please follow our traffic signs.

Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

Our survey markers will be installed at numerous locations within the Bayside Council area and do not necessarily indicate that there is a tunnel beneath the location of the survey marker.

How are we keeping our sites safe?

The safety and wellbeing of the wider community and our workers is our highest priority. We are working closely with our contractors to make sure COVID safe plans are in place including wearing masks and following appropriate hygiene and social distancing measures.



How will we continue to communicate with you?

We will continue to inform the community in advance about work activities via community notifications delivered to your letterbox. If at short notice NSW Government Health Orders change the timing of our work, we will provide updates on the M6 Stage 1 interactive portal.
