Sydney Gateway will provide a new, toll-free connection from St Peters Interchange to improve journey times to Sydney Airport, the M5 and Eastern Distributor.

3km+ of new pedestrian and cycling paths

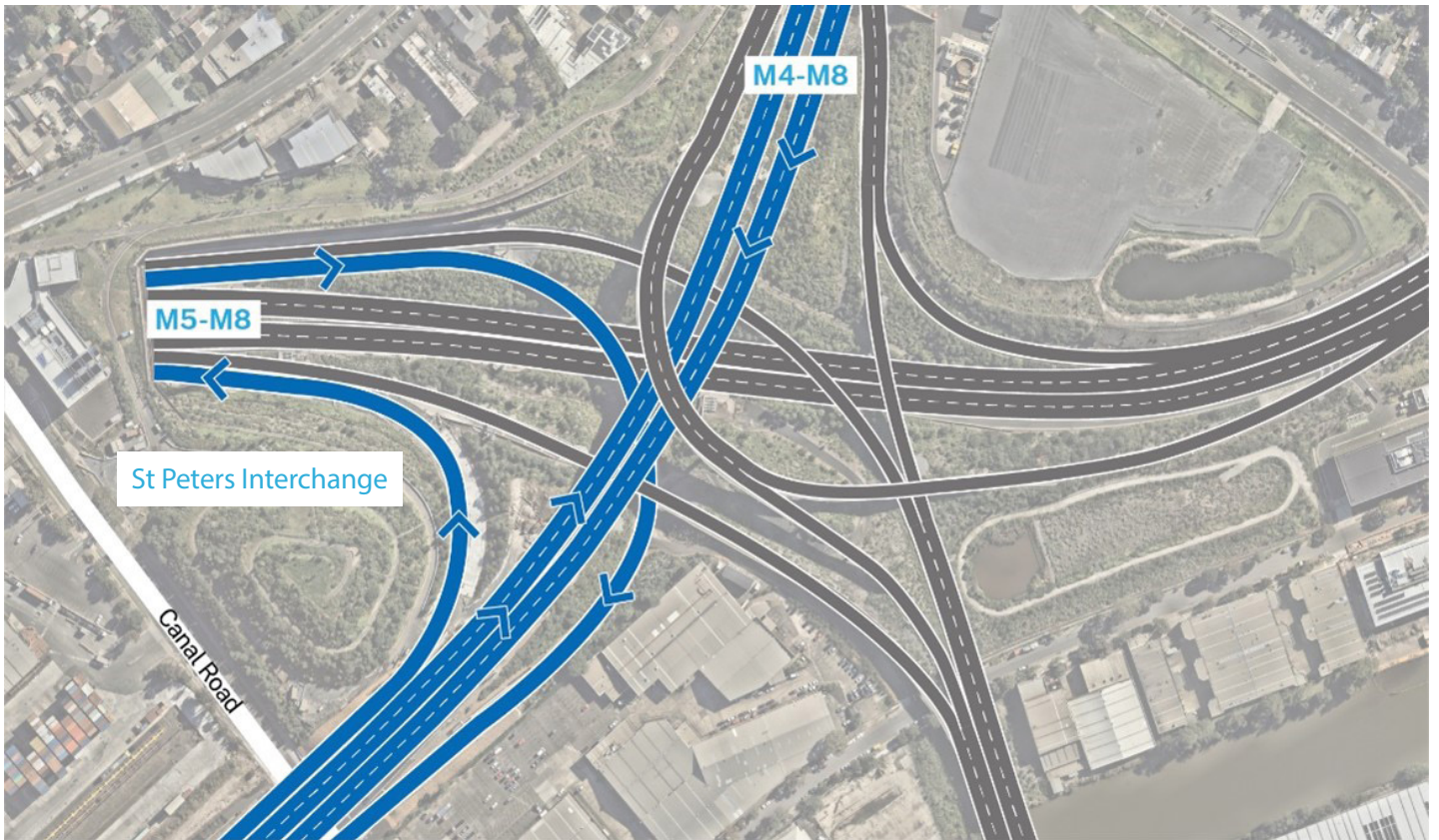
Sydney Gateway is targeting an open date from 1 September 2024. The final stage of the project is the connection to the wider motorway network at St Peters Interchange.

Since November 2023, the project has opened in stages, including the Deborah Lawrie Flyover into the Domestic Terminals, and two Twin Arch Bridges near the International Terminal. Opening has been staged to reduce impacts to road users.

Our website will continue to be updated with the latest information relating to Sydney Gateway opening.

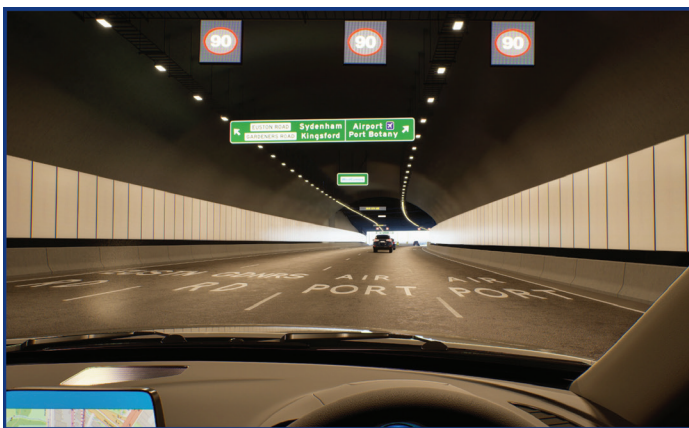

New Sydney Gateway roads connecting to the M8 tunnels

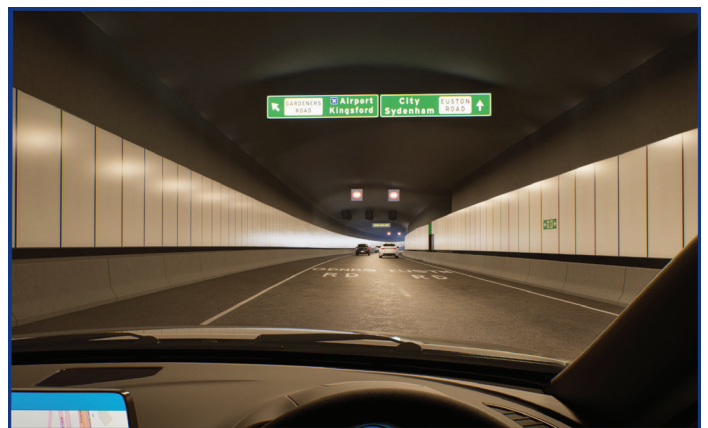
