Out of hours works at the intersection of Phillip Street and Dirrabarri Lane

Construction activity is well underway at the Powerhouse Parramatta project site. The next phase of construction will involve night and early morning works at the intersection of Phillip Street and Dirrabarri Lane.

Intersection of Phillip Street and Dirrabarri Lane, Parramatta

Night and early morning works

As part of ongoing high voltage infrastructure works in Dirrabarri Lane, night and early morning will be carried out to minimise impact to pedestrians and vehicle traffic. This will take place across two phases.

Strict environmental and planning controls are in place to manage noise, dust and vibration. The health, wellbeing and safety of the community and our workforce remain our top priority.

Removal of localised concrete slabs

Localised concrete slabs will be removed across three consecutive nights from Monday 25 July 2022 to Wednesday 27 July 2022 (weather permitting) from 7:30pm until 5:30am, with expected noisy works until 10:30pm.

Cable termination and temporary pavement

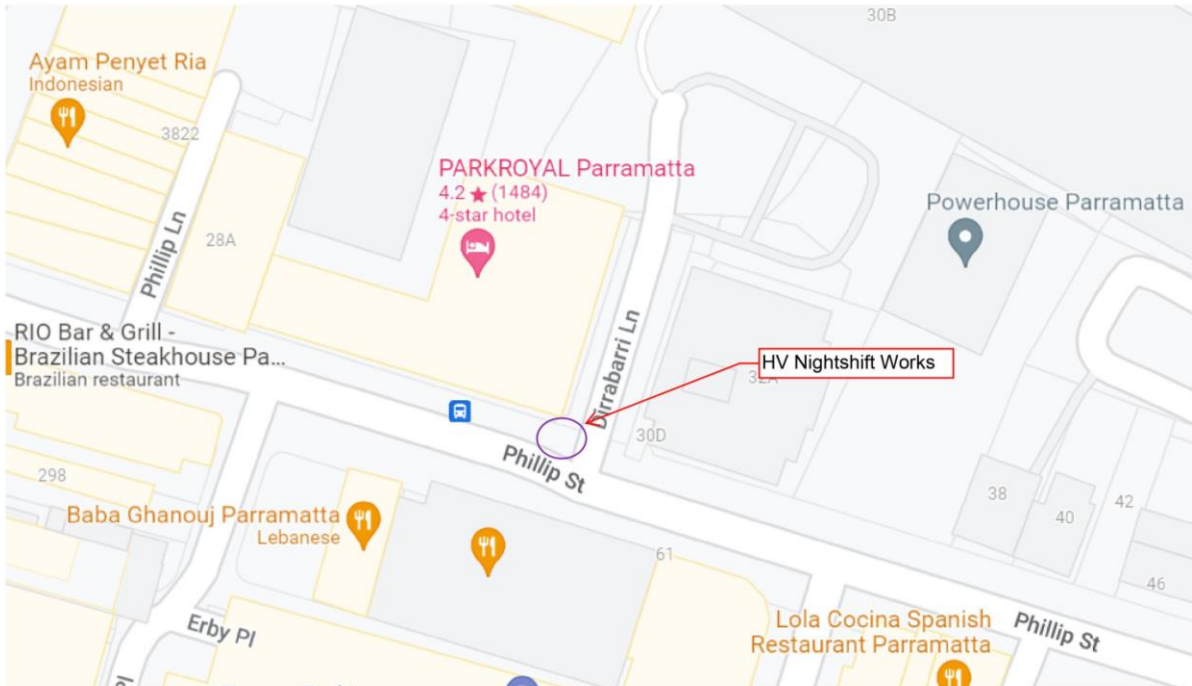
Cables will be pulled and terminated and temporary pavement backfilled across two consecutive nights from Thursday 28 July 2022 to Friday 29 July 2022 (weather permitting) from 7:30pm until 5:30am. Noisy works are not expected.

Pedestrian access and traffic control

Temporary pedestrian access changes are required throughout this work. Pedestrian access will be maintained via Phillip Street westbound.

Vehicle traffic on Dirrabarri Lane and Phillip Street will be managed through traffic controllers as required.
