

# M6 Stage 1

### Vegetation removal at Scarborough Park from Monday 17 January 2022

#### About the M6 Stage 1

The M6 Stage 1 will connect President Avenue at Kogarah to the M8 at Arncliffe via a four kilometre tunnel, linking southern Sydney to the wider motorway network.

#### Latest update

Between Monday 17 January and Friday 11 February 2022, we will be carrying out vegetation removal work in Scarborough Park in preparation for construction of a shared bicycle and pedestrian pathway to expand the existing active transport network and improve pedestrian and cyclist safety.

#### What does our work involve?

Vegetation removal work involves setting up site fencing around the work area and removing vegetation within sections of Scarborough Park.

We will use equipment including an excavator, mulcher, electrical saw, hand tools and light vehicles.

Traffic control will be in place to allow for the delivery of machinery and equipment at the intersection of O'Connell Street, Chuter Avenue and Robinson Street, and the intersection of Civic Avenue near Annette Avenue.

#### **Our work schedule**

Our work will take up to five weeks to complete between Monday 17 January and Friday 11 February 2022.

Our standard construction work hours are:

- 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday
- 8am to 6pm, Saturday

A map of our work area is shown over the page.

The dates and timing of work are subject to change depending on the weather and site conditions.

#### How will our work affect you?

The entrances to Scarborough Park at the intersection of O'Connell Street, Chuter Avenue and Robinson Street, and the intersection of Civic Avenue near Annette Avenue will be temporarily closed. Please follow our traffic signs and the directions of our traffic controllers.

Access to the park will be maintained through alternate entry points.

Our work is expected to create some noise. We will implement mitigation measures such as using squawkers instead of beepers on vehicles and by turning off equipment and vehicles when they are not being used.

Pedestrian and motorist access along President Avenue, O'Connell Street, Chuter Avenue, Barton Street and Civic Avenue will be maintained at all times.

#### How are we keeping our sites safe?

Temporary fencing will be in place around our work zones for the safety of the wider community and our workers.

We are working closely with our contractors to make sure COVID safe plans are in place and we are following current NSW Government Public Health Orders.

# How will we continue to communicate with you?

We will continue to inform the community in advance about work activities via community notifications delivered to your letterbox.



We understand some activities may cause disruption to the local community and we aim to complete this work as quickly as possible. We thank you for your patience as we undertake this important work.
