Weekend work on President Avenue

1 March 2025

Work to install signs and traffic management equipment will continue on President Avenue, near O'Connell Street.

This work will take place on Saturdays, from 8 March until 19 April. We will notify you in advance of the upcoming work.

This work will involve using piling machinery to create a shaft for future signage and signalling. Traffic lanes will be reduced. Traffic flow will be maintained around the work area.

This work will cause a high level of noise and vibration.

We apologise for the disruption this will cause and we will complete the work as quickly as possible. Thank you for your patience.

When and where we will be working

Work will take place from 7am to 7pm, with high impact work between 8am and 6pm. During this time, there will be pedestrian diversions, traffic changes, lane closures and temporary “no stopping” on President Avenue. Please allow extra time and follow the directions of traffic control.

How we manage impacts

- **Pause** high impact noise and vibration activities **every three hours** to provide respite
- Regularly **monitor noise and vibration** near our sites
- Ensure appropriate mitigation measures are in place, including installing temporary fencing with noise blankets.
