M7-M12 Integration project

April 2024



We acknowledge the Dharug people of the Darug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The M7-M12 Integration project will support future development growth in Western Sydney by improving travel times and congestion. Once complete, the project will provide direct access to commercial and residential hubs, and the new Western Sydney International Airport.

What work are we doing?

We will carry out bridge foundation and preparation work on Hoxton Park Road and within the median under the M7 Motorway bridges.

Bridge foundation work will take place over the following dates, subject to approval and weather permitting:

- Friday 3 May to Monday 6 May 2024
- Friday 10 May to Monday 13 May 2024
- Friday 17 May to Monday 20 May 2024 (contingency)

Preparation work will take place over one night shift, between **Thursday 18 April** and **Thursday 2 May 2024**.

Work will include:

- establishing work areas
- delivery and mobilisation of plant, equipment and materials to site work areas
- removal and reinstallation of temporary barriers

- pilling
- concrete pours for bridges
- setting up traffic control.

Our work schedule

Our night shift work hours are between **8pm** and **5am**, from **Monday** to **Friday morning** and weekend work will take place from **7pm Friday evening** to **5am Monday morning**.

We will not complete noisy work more than two (2) nights in a row, three (3) nights in a week and ten (10) nights in a month in the same location.

What equipment will be used?

During our work we may use, a mobile crane, excavator, lighting towers, concrete saw, piling rig, hand and power tools, concrete truck and pump and traffic control equipment.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes including reduced speed limits, lane closures and footpath diversions. Road and footpath users will be notified of temporary traffic changes via on-site signage and variable message signs (VMS).

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. Traffic control will be in place to assist traffic and pedestrians safely around the work sites.






Managing our impacts
