

Gold Coast Highway traffic changes

Kratzmann to Fifth avenues, Burleigh Heads

A work area will be established from 16 October 2023 in the southbound lanes of the Gold Coast Highway between Kratzmann and Fifth avenues, Burleigh Heads. The work area will allow for utility relocation and road works to occur throughout 2023 and 2024.

What to expect

Phase 1 - Site establishment

- Establishing a construction zone with fencing and barriers in the southbound lanes of the Gold Coast Highway between Kratzmann and Fifth avenues, Burleigh Heads (see map overleaf)
- Night works are required from 16 October for up to two weeks to undertake site establishment works
- Periods of increased noise while line marking is removed with high pressure water.

Phase 2 – Utilities and Phase 3 - Road works

- Existing utilities, need to be relocated, upgraded and in some instances, new services installed
- Utilities to be relocated include water, gas, sewerage, electricity, communication cables, stormwater drainage and signal cables
- Construction of new roads, curbs, footpaths
- Increase in noise and vibration associated with the use of heavy machinery including saw-cutting, jack hammering, concrete works, non-destructive digging and installing utility infrastructure.

Traffic changes

- On-street parking will be removed
- Changes to local vehicle access within works areas. Motorists including customers, staff, maintenance, waste, and delivery drivers can continue to access driveways by following 'local access' traffic signage

- At times driveways may be temporarily unavailable. Advanced notice will be provided to impacted residents and businesses about any changes
- The intersection of Gold Coast Highway and Sixth Avenue, Burleigh Heads will permanently close
- Bus stop relocations and closures on the northbound and southbound carriageways, for up-to-date information on bus stop closures go to www.translink.com.au.

Timing

Day works from 23 October to mid-2024

Night works from 16 October for two weeks between 6.30pm to 6.30am, Sunday night to Friday morning.

Additional night works will be required at times. Advance notification will be provided via email updates.

No works will occur on public holidays unless otherwise notified.

Wet weather or unforeseen circumstances may result in changes to the work schedule.

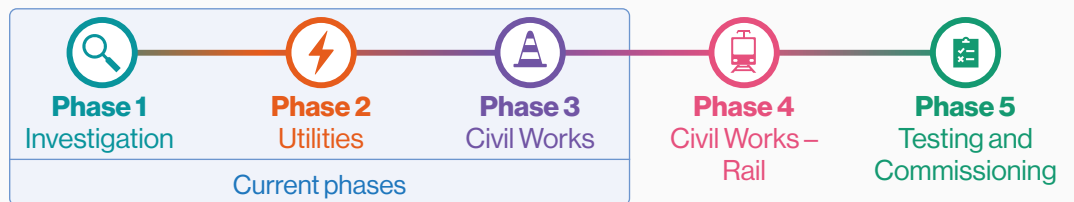
Works area
