In June 2025, we will be continuing consecutive weekend day and night work along the freeway and intersections in North Sydney and Neutral Bay, to speed up the work programme and reduce our overall impact to the surrounding community.







Temporary footpath realignment along High Street east, North Sydney


We are continuing with pavement installation work along High Street east, as part of our work to upgrade the High Street interchange to improve safety, connectivity, and efficiency in the North Sydney area.

On Friday 20 June 2025, we will be temporarily diverting pedestrians onto the temporary footpath alignment along High Street east, between Alfred Street North and High Street, North Sydney. The temporary footpath will be realigned to the east, with work areas on both sides. This temporary pedestrian diversion will allow us to complete pavement installation work on High Street east, North Sydney.

This change will be in place for approximately three months, weather and ground conditions permitting.

Additional footpath realignment and pedestrian diversion work will need to take place along High Street east, at a later stage. We will notify you in advance.

Traffic control and signage will be in place for the safety of pedestrians, cyclists and road users around our work areas. Please follow directions from traffic control at all times.

Managing our impacts and extended weekend work

Some of the work activities will require the use of machinery that generates noise, light, and vibration. We implement extensive controls to ensure any noise impacts are mitigated as much as possible.

To minimise the impact of this work we will:

- turn off machinery when not in use
- use acoustic blankets to minimise noise, where practicable
- direct temporary lighting down and away from properties
- fit equipment with devices to minimise noise, particularly non-tonal reversing beepers.

Our standard Environmental Protection Licence (EPL) conditions permit us to work up to three nights per week and up to ten nights per month, with no more than two consecutive nights of high noise work. We have been granted a temporarily altered EPL in instances where extended work shifts can provide benefits to the community, such as substantially reducing the duration of time it takes to complete a work activity, or when the work cannot be completed during single night work shifts.

The temporarily altered EPL condition allows us to work on consecutive noisy nights during extended weekend shifts usually from 10pm Friday until 4.30am Monday. The altered condition will continue to allow work on no more than ten nights per month in each work location.

During the extended work, we will make productive use of the lower traffic volumes to set up road closures and complete as much work as we can over the weekend, expediting the overall project work schedule.
