



Ongoing construction of the shared pedestrian and cyclist pathway from Civic Avenue to Chuter Avenue

M6 Stage 1

December 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Bidjigal, Dharawal, Gweagal and Gadigal clans of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

M6 Stage 1 will connect President Avenue at Kogarah to the M8 at Arncliffe via four-kilometre twin tunnels, linking southern Sydney to the wider motorway network.

Construction of a five-kilometre shared pedestrian and cyclist pathway to expand the active transport network continues. Once the pathways are constructed, we will provide renewed natural landscapes, green spaces, and recreational facilities for the community to enjoy.

What work are we doing?

Our daytime work includes:

- construction of the pedestrian bridge, including excavating and pouring concrete for the foundation of the spiral ramp
- constructing piles for the foundation of Scarborough Park boardwalks
- constructing temporary foundations to support large plant equipment, including piling rigs
- upgrading drainage in Scarborough Park
- delivery of materials, such as gravel, sandstone, concrete, reinforcement, ongoing earthworks, and vegetation removal
- maintaining environmental controls to manage erosion and sediment, as well as dust and noise mitigation

- widening site boundary near Scarborough Park.

Our night-time activities include:

- delivery of piles and oversized plant equipment.

Our equipment includes excavators, cranes, piling rigs, tippers, telehandler, mulcher, stump grinder, concrete pumps, concrete trucks, concrete saws, compactors, rollers, hand tools, trucks and light vehicles, such as utes.

When and where we'll be working

In December, work continues between Civic Avenue and Chuter Avenue through Scarborough Park.

Our standard work hours are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm, Saturday.**

Out-of-hours deliveries will take place at our Chuter Avenue site access on:

- **Friday 15 December**

Dates and timing of work are subject to change depending on weather and site conditions.

What will this mean for you?

The footpath in Scarborough Park (from Civic Avenue to Chuter Avenue) is closed until the pathway is complete in 2024. Access to Scarborough Park and Civic Reserve is maintained through alternate entrances on Civic Avenue near the intersection of Marshall Street and south of the intersection at Annette Street, as well as on Chuter Avenue near the intersection of Robinson Street.



Temporary road lane closures on the southern side of President Avenue may occur during the delivery and relocation of oversized plants. Pedestrian changes will be in place when we are working close to the road or footpath.

The pedestrian pathway on the southern side of President Avenue remains closed with pedestrian and cyclist access available on the northern side. Please follow our traffic signs and the directions of our traffic controllers.

Managing our impacts

We will manage dust by using a water cart and manage noise by using squawkers instead of beepers on vehicles and turn off equipment and vehicles when they are not being used. We use noise and dust monitoring to measure our impact to the local community.

Respite for one hour will occur every three hours during high impact day activities (this will usually be at 11am and 3pm Monday to Friday and at 11am on Saturday).

President Avenue bridge

The columns and foundation for the future pedestrian bridge over President Avenue is taking shape. Columns are now visible on the southern and northern side of President Avenue between West Botany Street and O'Neill Street. The bridge will allow pedestrians and cyclists to cross President Avenue safely and easily once completed.
