



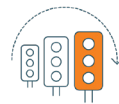
## Central North Construction Precinct

### Start of Works

The River Torrens to Darlington (T2D) Project is the final 10.5 kilometre section of the North-South Corridor, and will:



**Complete 78 kilometres of non-stop, traffic light free motorway between Gawler and Old Noarlunga.**



**Allow drivers to bypass 21 sets of traffic lights between the River Torrens and Darlington as they travel between two separate tunnels, connected by an open motorway.**

### What's happening

Work at the Central North Construction Precinct is due to **start in mid-March 2025**.

The Central North Construction Precinct is the new construction area between **Sir Donald Bradman Drive, Hilton, and Keswick Creek, Richmond**. This is where we will build and launch the Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) to construct the northern tunnel of the T2D Project. You can find a map of the construction area on the following page.

## Local road changes

### Site Establishment

From **Monday 17 March**, crews will be working on site to establish the construction site, including the closure of several local roads to create a site boundary.

Standard work hours will be **7am to 7pm, Monday to Saturday**. Some works outside these hours will be required. We will notify you of these works in advance.


Works occurring over the coming months on site will include:

-  Surveying inside the site, along South Road and adjacent streets.
-  Installation of a temporary noise wall along the western property boundary and site fencing on other boundaries.
-  Ground levelling, vegetation clearing and construction of concrete hard stand areas to prepare for construction of site office buildings.
-  Construction of internal haulage roads.

Pedestrian access to South Road will be via Sir Donald Bradman Drive while these initial works are undertaken. Further access changes may be required in the future, and we will provide you updates as we know more.

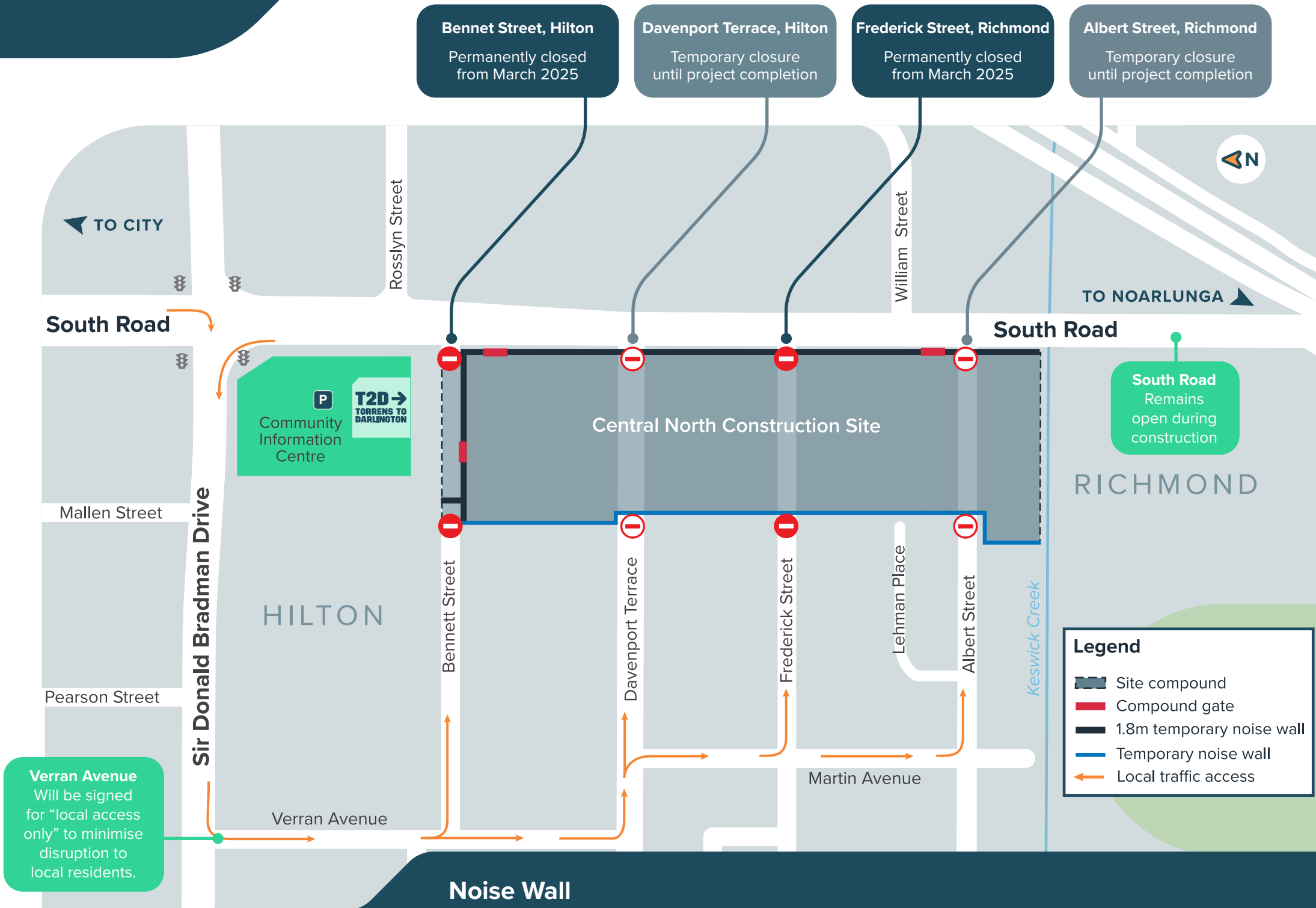
Over the coming months, we will also provide more details about what you can expect as the site is constructed, and how the tunnelling site will operate in the future.

### Night works for local road changes

-  Removal of the right turn lane on South Road into these side streets will be undertaken at night to **reduce the interruption to traffic on South Road**. Works will occur over 7 nights from Monday, 17 March. **Night work hours are 7pm to 7am, Monday to Saturday**.

### Local road closures

To create space for the tunnelling site to be constructed, **several local roads will need to be closed from Monday, 17 March**.



### Noise Wall

A noise wall will be constructed along the western side of the Central North Construction Precinct, as a **barrier for noise** between **tunnelling operations and local residents**.

The noise wall will be constructed of a material and at a height that offers effective noise mitigation for local residents from the work site. It will be set within the boundary of the site so existing boundary fences will be maintained.
