Work update
October 2023



Sydney Gateway will provide a new, toll-free connection from St Peters Interchange to improve journey times to Sydney Airport, the M5 and Eastern Distributor.

Our work in October 2023 includes:

Work near the International Terminal



Work continues preparing the southbound Twin Arch Bridge for launch at our Tempe site.

- Finishing works on the northbound Twin Arch Bridge including concrete works, asphaltting and installation of traffic barriers including out-of-hours activities.
- Continuing works to prepare the southbound Twin Arch Bridge for launch in the coming weeks including out-of-hours activities.
- Upgrading the stormwater system on Link Road including approximately 3 weeks of out-of-hours activities from 24 September.
- General road finishing works on Airport Drive including out-of-hours activities.

In mid November 2023 we will start to make traffic switches around the Airport Precinct. Scan the QR code to learn more.



Work near the Domestic Terminals



Ongoing day and night-time Flyover construction activities along Qantas Drive and Sir Reginald Ansett Drive, Mascot.

- Road widening activities westbound and eastbound on Qantas Drive includes installing underground services, barrier installation, new pavement work and gantry installation over Airport Drive.
- Night-time construction of drainage, underground services, installation of steel structures, pavement, asphalt and road barriers on Qantas Drive between Lancastrian and Robey Streets.
- Night-time installation of underground services across O'Riordan Street at Qantas Drive, Mascot.
- Ongoing day and night-time Flyover construction activities along Qantas Drive and Sir Reginald Ansett Drive, Mascot. Work involves out-of-hour girder, architectural screens and barrier installation including oversize vehicle deliveries.
- Concrete barrier adjustments on Qantas Drive, Mascot near the overhead bridge.
- Traffic signal modifications in preparation for the final project completion, in this area.

Tempe and St Peters



Ongoing construction of the bridge and road works across Canal Road, St Peters.

- Continuing road and bridge works within the Tempe site including asphaltting and installation of traffic barriers, streetlights, and road signage.
- Installing power to the pedestrian and cycle path from Tempe Recreation Reserve near the path's intersection with Billy's Bridge.
- Demobilising the Tempe site. This includes daytime access to the Tempe site for construction vehicles via Holbech Avenue, Tempe.
- Ongoing construction of the bridge across Canal Road, St Peters. This includes some weekend works and traffic contraflows on Canal Road.

How our work may impact you

We'll use plant and equipment that includes hand tools, welding tools, cranes, grinders, excavators, piling rigs, elevated work platforms, vacuum trucks, ground compactors, vibratory rollers, asphalt pavers, jack hammers, road saws, rattle guns, chain saws, traffic management tools and construction vehicles.

We'll minimise noise associated with this work by using non-tonal reversing beepers on machinery, turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use, using noise mats and noise shielding, where feasible, directing noisy equipment away from properties and other on-site noise reduction measures.

Across multiple locations



Continuing construction of the pedestrian and cycle path along Alexandra Canal.

- Oversized deliveries of bridge structures, materials and equipment to our work sites at Mascot, Tempe and St Peters. This may include out-of-hours heavy vehicle deliveries, lifting activities and concrete pours.
- Landscaping across the project.
- Continuing construction of the pedestrian and cycle path. This includes occasional night-time path closures with an on-demand bus service as well as intermittent narrowing of the path under stop-go traffic control.

Our work hours

Our standard work will take place during the day from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and from **8am to 6pm on Saturdays**. We'll also be working at night usually up to **3 nights a week between 6pm - 7am**.

Some of our work may be done outside of these hours when it's low impact, required for safety reasons or prescribed by regulatory authorities. This includes Sydney Airport regulations which require the use of large cranes and other oversized equipment to be used at night when planes are not using the Airport.

Traffic (including pedestrian and cycling) conditions will change while we're working. Please plan ahead and follow the direction of traffic controllers.
