Overview




Stage 2 and 3 Bridge Road works will involve:

- Widening of Bridge Road to allow establishment of bus and taxi drop-off zones
- Establishment of traffic lights at the Wentworth Park Road intersection, providing access to the new Sydney Fish Market driveway entrance as well as signalised pedestrian crossings
- Extension of the eastbound right-hand turn lane from Bridge Road into Wattle Street
- Establishment of a westbound right-hand turn lane from Bridge Road into the new Sydney Fish Market
- Drainage, kerb, and road surface works
- Signage and line marking
- Renewed street lighting








Bridge Road Upgrade





Stage 2A



Stage 2A Road works will involve:

- Pavement (road surface) construction at the intersection of Bridge Road and Wentworth Park Road
- Establishment of traffic lights at the intersection of Bridge Road and Wentworth Park Road, including signalised pedestrian crossings
- Associated kerb and stormwater works


Work will be mainly undertaken over five weekends

Stage 2B



Stage 2B Road works will involve:

- Roadworks on the northern (site) side of Bridge Road to widen the road and establish the new bus and taxi drop-off zones
- Closure of the northern footpath adjacent to site
- Pedestrians and cyclists will be diverted via the new signalised pedestrian crossings from the northern footpath to the southern (Wentworth Park) footpath to enable works to the northern side of Bridge Road
- Associated stormwater, kerb and pavement works

Scheduling

 Work will be mainly completed as day shifts, with night works undertaken when necessary






Stage 3 Finishing works will involve:

- Road surface treatments
- Line marking, including extension of the eastbound right-hand turn lane into Wattle Street and establishment of a westbound right-hand turn lane into the new Sydney Fish Market driveway
- Permanent traffic signals
- Street lighting
- Signage


Scheduling



Impacts and mitigation

- Lane closures as well as pedestrian and cyclist diversions will be necessary at times with guidance in place
- Work will be a combination of day works, night works and weekend works
- Schedules and mitigation measures will be determined in consideration of conditions of approval (Bridge Road CMTMP & CNVMP) as well as authority requirements and management of local impacts
- Notifications will be issued in keeping with existing protocols, as needed via direct email to construction database and also available on the project website
- The road works will be progressively opened to the public in a sequence that accommodates construction of the new Sydney Fish Markets precinct




