T2D → **TORRENS TO DARLINGTON**

South Road weekend closure, Marlestone

July 2026

The River Torrens to Darlington (T2D) Project is South Australia's largest infrastructure project and will create a non-stop South Road between Gawler and Old Noarlunga.

What's happening

South Road, between Richmond Road and Anzac Highway, will be closed from 8pm Friday 24 July to 5am Monday 27 July 2026.

This temporary closure is to allow for construction of a new sewer main, and other utility works. Works include excavation, cutting and laying pipe, and reinstalment of the road.

South Road will remain open for access to businesses, with assistance on site from traffic control. Please follow signage and continue to support local businesses.

Works during the day will continue within the T2D worksites along South Road, between Richmond Road and Anzac Highway.

How this affects you

Detours will be in place for all road users, pedestrians and cyclists (refer to detour map over the page for details). Access for residents will be maintained via the local roads.

Bus services operating along South Road between Richmond Road and Anzac Highway will be temporarily diverted during the closure. Visit adelaidemetro.com.au for more information.

Please observe signage and take care when travelling through the area. We encourage all road users, residents and businesses to plan ahead and where necessary, allow extra travel time.

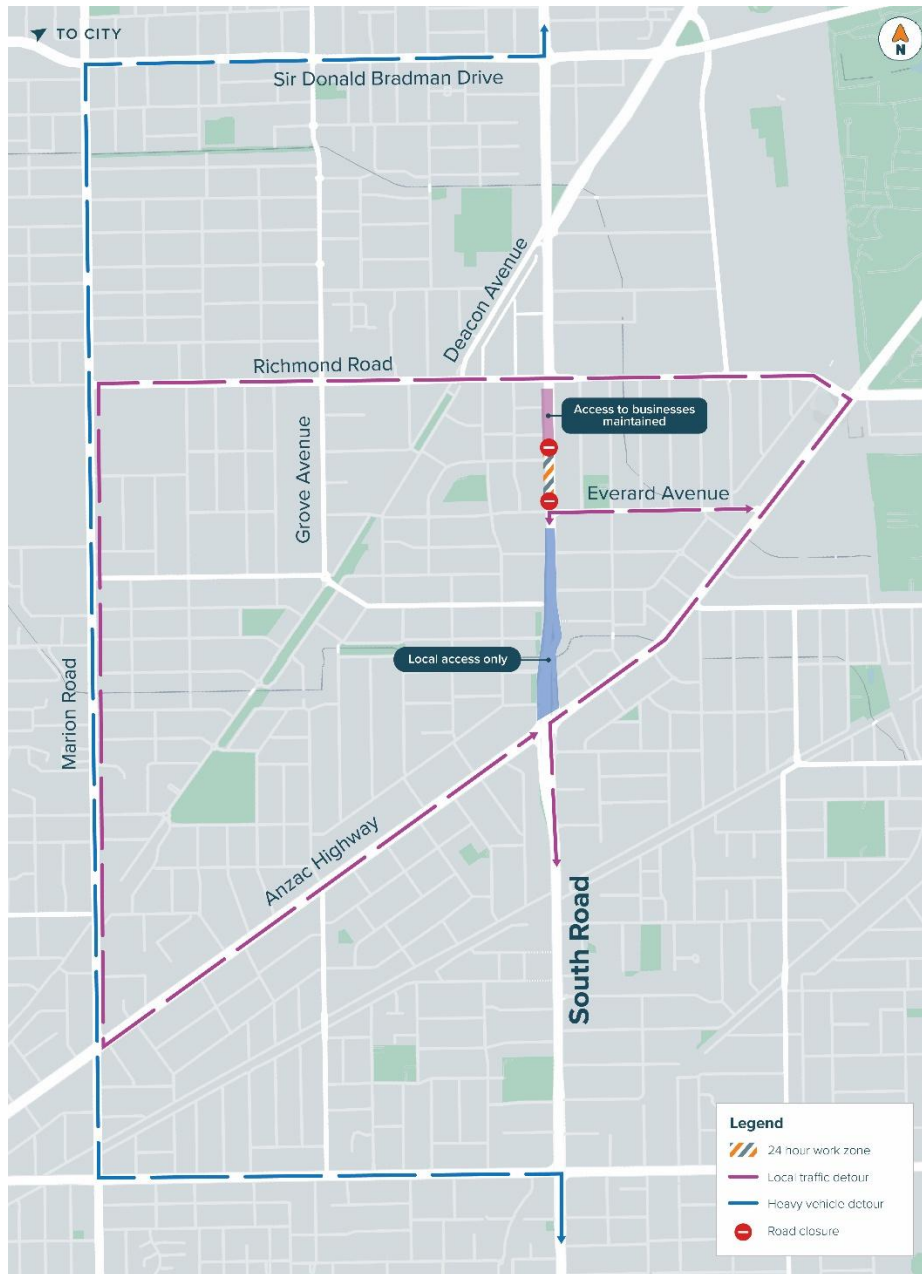
