Aims	 Generate excitement about the project and the changes coming Opportunity to discuss and test their knowledge and apply their learnings from the safety video in a hands-on setting Encourage students to be creative in producing their own picture or artwork Explore the different modes of transport work together Reinforce vocabulary and concepts introduced in the safety video around safety.
Overview	 Discussion about various ways students can and do travel around the city. Inform students that Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 3 is currently under construction. Optional - Watch the 'Be a safety Superhero' video (4 minutes) Students complete the find a word in the activity booklet - Word search puzzle with nine hidden words related to light rail and safety Discuss as a class or individually, a series of statement about safety and PPE are presented with students finding a missing word from the list and matching it with the appropriate sentence. Students work individually or in groups to colour in a scene featuring Light Rail.
