Bridge Road - changes to traffic and pedestrian

movements

Dear neighbour

The NSW Government is delivering a new Sydney Fish Market which will retain its authentic experience and strengthen its position as one of Australia's leading tourist destinations.

Upcoming work - tree removal and investigative works

From Friday, 13 August 2021, tree removal and pavement testing along Bridge Road will be carried out 7:00am to 5:30pm Monday to Friday and 7:00am to 5:00pm Saturday for a period of up to one week. It is noted that these dates are subject to change pending inclement weather, and potential impacts of the NSW Government lockdown restrictions.

The works will involve:

- The removal of trees that have been approved for removal as part of the development consent to accommodate the future pedestrian corridor along Bridge Road (see Figure 1 for tree removal locations).




Figure 2: Bridge Road investigation works location

- Pavement testing along Bridge Road between Wattle Street and Wentworth Park Road that will
 involve taking a total of eight core hole samples along Bridge Road to assist in road pavement
 design for the future Bridge Road upgrade (see Figure 2 for core hole locations).

How this affects you

The work will require closing multiple Bridge Road lanes and footpath (closest to the construction site, shown as 'work zone' in the diagram) between Wentworth Park Road and Wattle Street, during the above-mentioned construction hours. The following diversions will be in place during construction hours:

- Diverting vehicles and cyclists around the work zone, by temporarily reducing both directions of traffic to one lane.
- Diverting pedestrians across Bridge Road and along Wentworth Park. Traffic controllers will be in place to safely assist pedestrians to cross the road.

The work zone will be removed at the end of each day, and travel along Bridge Road will continue as normal outside the construction hours.

We understand the potential impacts this may cause to our neighbours. Thank you for your understanding during this work.




Figure 3: Pedestrian diversion during tree removal works
