Night works – electrical feeder investigations

Dear neighbour

The NSW Government is delivering an authentic new Sydney Fish Market (SFM) which will sit at the heart of a revitalised Blackwattle Bay and return inaccessible parts of the harbour foreshore to the community.

As part of the development, a new electrical feeder line is required in order to energize the new precinct.

Site investigation work – Bridge Road (from Lyons Road to Wattle Street)

Multiplex will be undertaking investigation work in your area from 8 March to 9 April 2021 (see location map overleaf).

The proposed route for the line is from the zone substation at Lyons Road in Camperdown to the new SFM site.

Work will involve two stages of investigations - service scanning and potholing. The works will be undertaken at night and will be staged to provide respite to impacted residents. There are no daytime impacts.

Hours of work

Working hours will be between 8pm to 5am, Monday to Friday. This is to minimise the impact on traffic and pedestrian movement.

High noise works such as saw cutting and pavement removal for the potholing will be undertaken early in the shifts to minimise impacts.

What to expect

There may be some impacts to traffic and pedestrian movements. Traffic control will be in place to guide vehicles and cyclists around the works zone. Safe alternative routes and crossings for pedestrians will also be provided.

Some kerbside parking spaces may be unavailable for short periods during the work. Driveway access for residents will be maintained.

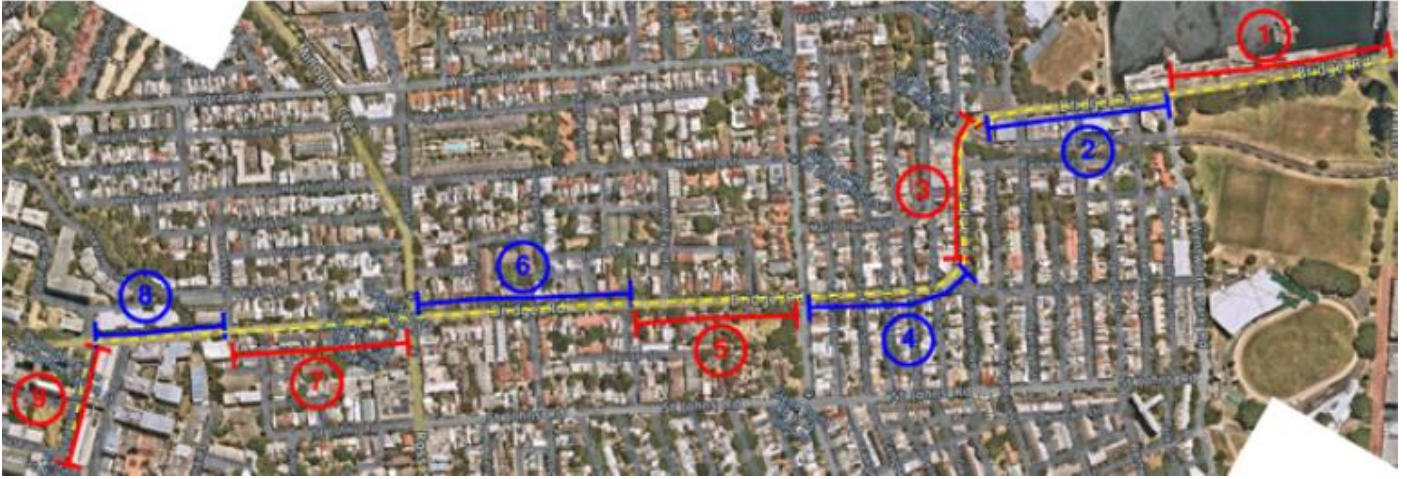

Scheduling of work

The following schedule is indicative only, to give residents an understanding of how many nights a week work will be carried out in their zone. It is subject to change and weather dependent.

Week 1 – Scanning

- Monday and Tuesday: areas 1,2 & 3
- Wednesday and Thursday: areas 4,5,6 & 7
- Friday: areas 8 & 9

Week 2 – Potholing

- Monday and Tuesday: areas 1 & 3
- Wednesday and Thursday: areas 5 & 7
- Friday: area 9

Week 3 – Potholing

- Monday and Tuesday: areas 2 & 4
- Wednesday and Thursday: areas 6 & 8
- Friday: area 1

Week 4 – Potholing

- Monday and Tuesday: areas 1, 2 & 3
- Wednesday and Thursday: areas 5, 6 & 7

Week 5 – Potholing

- Tuesday: area 8 & 9
- Wednesday and Thursday: areas 2, 4 & 6
- Friday: area 1 & 3
