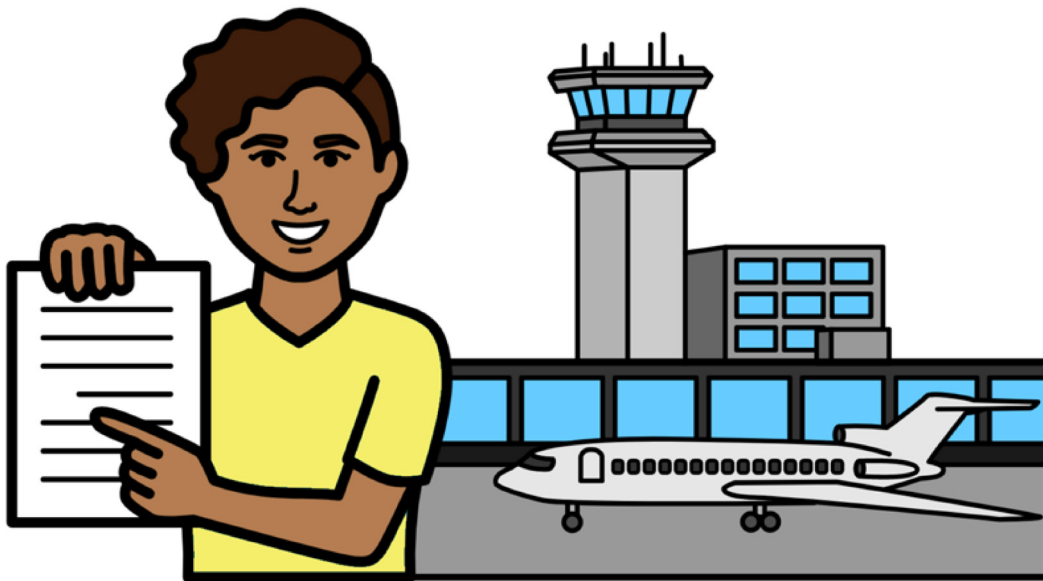

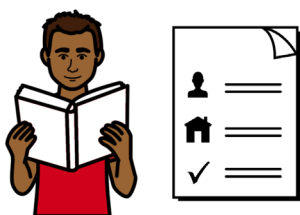

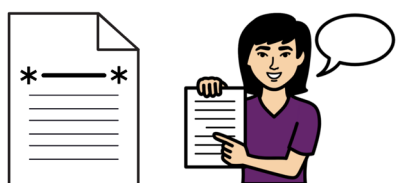

This booklet is from Melbourne Airport.



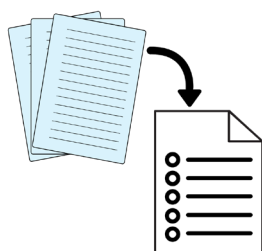
This is an Easy Read booklet.

What the plan says

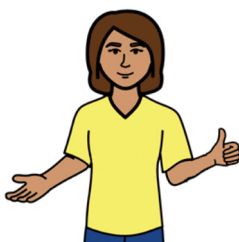
Passenger Growth



A lot more passengers will use Melbourne Airport in the future.

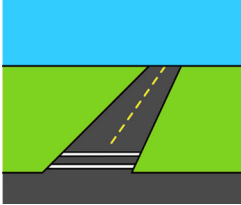


We think about 75 million passengers will use Melbourne Airport each year by 2047.



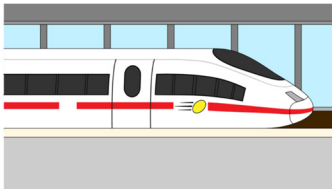
We need to be ready to support more passengers and planes.

Our plans for Melbourne Airport include

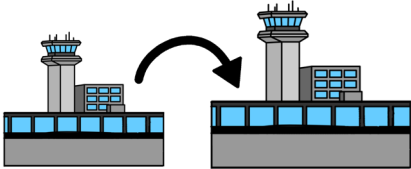
- new roads
- better bus connections
- a train from the airport to the city
- future fast trains to regional Victoria and New South Wales.



Bigger ***terminals***



Terminals means the airport buildings.



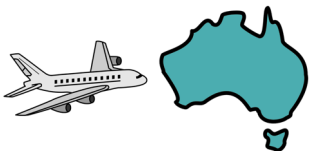
We will make the ***international*** terminal bigger.



International means planes take passengers overseas.



We will make the ***domestic*** terminals better for passengers.

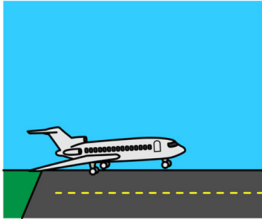


Domestic means planes take passengers around Australia.



We will find more land around the airport to make a new terminal in the future.

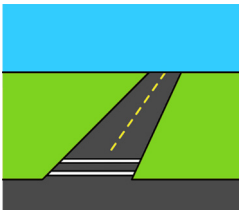
Changes to the ***airfield***



Airfield means the runways where the planes take off, land and move around.



We will build another runway to support more planes using Melbourne Airport.



We will build better roads for planes to move around the airport.



We will build more places for planes to park around the airport.

Support for Victoria



The plan will bring more money to Victoria to support people and businesses.



The plan will support over 50,000 jobs.

Accessibility



Accessibility means everyone can use the airport in ways they need.



We will make sure places and services that passengers use are accessible.

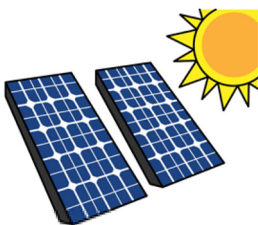


The airport will be easier for everyone to use.

Sustainability



Sustainability means we think about the environment when we build at the airport.



We will use ***renewable energy***.

Renewable energy means power that is better for the environment, like solar power from the sun.

Flight paths and plane noise



Sometimes airports and planes can add more noise to local areas.



For example, some people who live near the airport might hear loud noise when planes fly over the house.



We will tell our neighbours and community about how we will manage noise around the airport when we build new runways.

Land around the airport

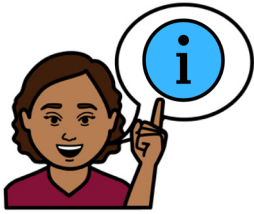


The plan will explain to the community what we will build on and around the airport.
