

Flyover to the Domestic Terminals

From 12 November 2023 you will be able to travel on Sydney Gateway's new Flyover into the Domestic Terminals.

As we make changes to how you move around the Airport Precinct, please travel with care, follow directional signs, maintain the required speed limit and plan your trip before travelling.



What will change when the Flyover opens?





Vehicles wanting to access the Domestic Terminals from Qantas Drive will use the new 800-metre-long Flyover. The current right turn from Qantas Drive onto Sir Reginald Ansett Drive will no longer be permitted.



Trucks travelling east on Qantas Drive will have an improved journey as result of increased left turn capacity at Robey Street and the removal of the right turn from Qantas Drive.



KEY

-  To Robey Street, Eastern Distributor and Port Botany
-  Eastbound traffic uses new Flyover to access Domestic Terminals

The right lane is a dedicated lane onto the Flyover which gives direct access to the Domestic Terminals. The remaining two lanes on Qantas Drive provide improved access to Robey Street, the Eastern Distributor and Port Botany.



The Flyover becomes two lanes, with one lane providing direct access to Arrivals and the other to Departures.



No access to the Domestic Terminals from Qantas Drive into Sir Reginald Ansett Drive. No change to access from Joyce Drive and O'Riordan Street.



Sydney Airport Domestic Terminals

The Flyover will connect with Sydney Airport's existing Arrivals and Departures lanes at these locations.

There is no change to how you leave the airport.



What other traffic changes will I see as part of Sydney Gateway?

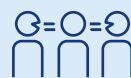
