



Be a safety superhero!

Classroom session

Session time: 100 minutes

Facilitator: Gold Coast Light Rail Stage 3 project representatives or class teacher

Resources required

- Access to a computer and projector including audio for delivery of a presentation
- Drawing and colouring-in materials
- Art competition template and supporting activities.

Learning intention

The Safety Hero classroom session features our very own Sally, the Safety Advisor on Stage 3, giving students unique insights into the project, while construction of this major transport project is still underway from Broadbeach to Burleigh Heads.

Students will

- Watch a safety video exploring items of PPE and safe behaviours
- Understand the importance of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- Have the opportunity to take part in a series of activities to build on knowledge and understanding from the presentation
- Revise how to report unsafe observations and issues.

Lesson ideas

Some simple activities are included in the session to encourage student participation and support learning outcomes. These activities can be hosted simultaneously (rotating small groups) following the presentation or built into teacher lesson plans individually.

- A project representative or teacher will guide students through a presentation about safety on Stage, including a four minute 'Be a safety superhero' video (60 minutes)
- Opportunity to deliver one or multiple (rotational groups) supporting activities:
 - Activity: Take part in the Science Tram Art Competition (40 minutes).
 - PPE match and learn activity (40 minutes)
 - Hard hat cut-out activity flyer (40 minutes)
 - Complete the Science Tram Activity booklet (40 minutes)
 - Jobs in construction – build a mini city (Longer activity - 60 minutes).
- Student PPE demonstration kit (30 mins) - *available to classroom sessions delivered by a Stage 3 project representative only*
